
Dear Ms. Colgan,

I refer to your letter of 26<sup>th</sup> November 2010 regarding a motion passed at your meeting of 23<sup>rd</sup> November relating to customer boarding times and the terminus at Foxborough.

Dublin Bus has been monitoring the loading patterns of customers immediate upon implementation of the revised services in the Lucan area. Due to the demand levels, additional capacity has been added to the corridor and this will be reviewed on a daily basis.

In regard to the terminus of route 151 representations have been made and Dublin Bus is actively engaging with relevant stakeholders to ensure that any disruption to residents is minimised. The road was realigned in this area so no disruption to traffic flows would ensue.
