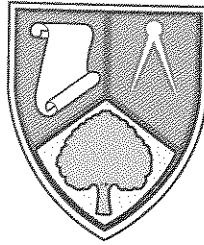
I would be obliged for your comment and response as soon as possible to enable me to revert to the Committee.

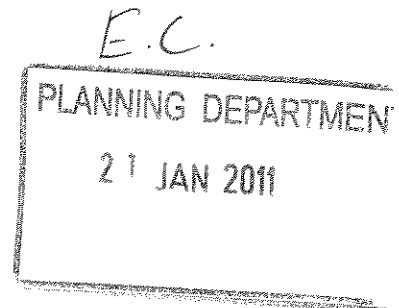
