## Dear Minister,

I wish to bring to your attention that Galway City Council at its meeting held on 14th May, 2012, resolved the following Motions as follows;

"I propose that Galway City Council oppose all efforts by the Minister for Environment to impose charges on all householders for the supply and fitting of water meters, this scheme should be funded by the Department of Environment. It was further agreed to circulate this motion to all other Local Authorities".

"That Galway City Council condemns the decision by the Minister for the Environment to establish the new public water utility company, Irish Water, without proper consultation with the City Council and notwithstanding the Council's opposition to its establishment"
