I wish to inform you that at the July Meeting of South Tipperary County council the Members unanimously passed the following resolution: -

"That this Council urges all the co-ops within the County to buy into the proposed Glanbia milk processing plant at the Bellview site because they will need more capacity for the extra milk produced after the abolishment of quotas in 2015. The joint venture between Glanbia PLC and Glanbia co-op is set to apply for planning permission for a Greenmilk milk processing plant on a 40 acre I.D.A. owned site at Belview on the Waterford/Kilkenny border. The proposed new 150 million plant will be two third the size of Ballyragget. It will contain two flexible 7.5 tonnes per hour dryer capable of processing the additional 800 million litres of milk glanbia are predicting between 2015 and 2020".
