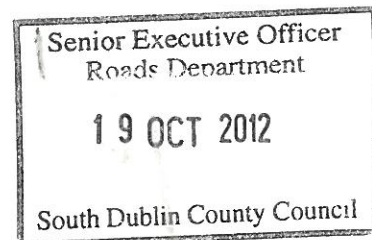

**RE: FUTURE OF WESTON AIRPORT, LUCAN.**

Dear Mr. Curtin,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 11 October, received yesterday and with the enclosed correspondence therein, dated 6 July. Thank you for corresponding with us on this matter.

The correspondences record that the Lucan Area Committee of the County Council seeks the scheduling of a meeting with NAMA, to be attended by a delegation including the Manager and elected members, to discuss the future of Weston Airport.

We would be happy to facilitate such a meeting and in this regard I will work with you to organise a mutually agreeable time. I can confirm that Weston Airport is under the control of a receiver (KPMG). I have spoken with Kieran Wallace of the KPMG who is in charge of the Weston Airport receivership.
