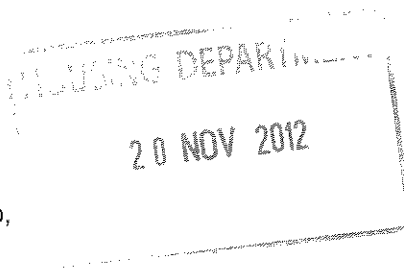

Subject: M50 Landscaping – Within South Dublin CoCo Boundary

Dear Eamon,

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 25th October 2012 expressing South Dublin County Councils concern with litter accumulations on the spiral sliproad at Junction 9 on the M50. We are currently acting as the National Road Authoritys Operations and Maintenance Representatives for the M50 PPP Scheme.

The M50 motorway mainline is currently being operated and maintained by M50 Concessions Ltd for a period of 35years under a PPP (Public Private Partnership) scheme. This includes for the operation and maintenance of the mainline from motorway boundary fence to motorway boundary fence but excludes the interchanges. The area referred to in your correspondence therefore falls outside the remit of the M50 PPP Company and lies instead with the relevant Local Authority.

M50 Concession Ltd will shortly be carrying out litter picking maintenance within the area from J7 to J10 on the M50. As a once off, act of good will, I have asked M50 Concession Ltd to include a full litter pick of J9 with these works, however any future litter picking, grass cutting etc will be the responsibility of South Dublin CoCo.

Included within the M50 PPP Contract are a set of drawings outlining the areas of responsibility of the PPP Company and also that of the Local Authorities. I am available to meet with South Dublin CoCo at a mutually convenient time to discuss these boundary areas.
