Thank you for your letter of 28th January, addressed to the former Chief Executive of Iarnród Éireann, Mr. Dick Fearn, concerning Kishogue station.

The documents you refer to in your letter were not attached, however, Kishogue Station is included in the current Programme for Government and was scheduled to be complete in 2013, however, capital funding to Iarnród Éireann, for 2013 has been reduced and consequently we are not in a position to complete the access road and car park, to facilitate the opening of the station in 2013.

The funding levels for 2014 and beyond have not been determined, consequently, we currently cannot commit to a firm date for opening within the Programme for Government.
