## **DIVISIONAL FIGURES:**

Property related crime is down by 3% on 2012.

There were 214 incidents of drugs for sale or supply recorded in 2013 an increase of 16% on 2012(185).

There were 597 incidents in 2013 for possession of drugs for personal use, as opposed to 800 in 2012, a decrease of 25% on 2012.

3,449 searches were carried out under the Misuse of Drugs Act in 2013. (3449 in 2012).

There were 207 detections for Driving a Mechanically Propelled Vehicle while intoxicated in 2013 as opposed to 266 in 2012, a decrease of 22%.

4 fatal road traffic accidents were recorded in 2013 as opposed to 0 in 2012.

639 incidents of public order were recorded in 2013 as opposed to 742 incidents in 2012, a decrease of 14%.

335 incidents of assault were recorded in 2013, as opposed to 357 in 2012, a decrease of 6%.

116 incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2013 as opposed to 118 in 2012, a decrease of 2%.
