The Minister has noted the Suspensory Motion agreed by South Dublin County Council. As you can appreciate, for reasons of confidentiality this Department is prohibited from commenting on or discussing the details of Mr. Halawa's case with a third party.

This Department has, since his detention, provided Mr. Ibrahim Halawa and his family with consular assistance. The Minister is seriously concerned at Ibrahim's continued detention and has directed that the Irish Embassy in Cairo and the Consular Assistance Section at the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade continue to provide all appropriate consular assistance.
