1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Report

The purpose of this Manager's Report is to present the outcome of the Part 8 proposed development consultation, to respond to submissions made during the consultation period and to make recommendations in relation to the proposed development, where appropriate.

2. Proposed Development in brief

1.1 Description of the Proposed Development

Stage 1:

- Provision of 2 no. 4 classroom temporary primary schools on the site located immediately to the east of Firhouse Community Centre between Killinniny Road and Ballycullen Drive, Firhouse for a period of up to 4 years.
- Provision of a permanent public car parking area for a minimum of 15 no. cars off Killinniny Road that will function as a drop-off area for the school and as a public car park outside of school hours.
- Provision of drop-off area for a minimum of 15 no. cars and staff car parking to north of temporary schools to be accessed off Ballycullen Drive.
- New road markings along Killininny Road to provide access/egress to new car park.
- Realignment of existing footpath between Ballycullen Drive/Killinniny Road to provide new pedestrian/cyclist link between Firhouse Community Centre and proposed temporary schools.
- Existing pedestrian gate at Killinniny Road to be retained.

Stage 2:

 Removal of 2 no. 4 classroom schools after a temporary period of four years and reconstruction of the site as public playground.

1.2 Plans and Details

The Plans and Details are attached in Appendix 1.

3. Outline of Public Consultation Programme

3.1 Statutory Consultation

The Part 8 proposals were presented to the Tallaght Area Committee Meeting held on Monday 27th May 2013.

The proposed development, plans and particulars were placed on public display for the statutory period of six weeks from Thursday, 30th May 2013 until Friday 12th July 2013 during which time information was disseminated to the public and submissions were invited as follows:

- Public notice was advertised in The Echo 30th May 2013 which included an invitation for submissions or observations on the proposed development.
- Plans and particulars were available to view and download from the SDCC website www.sdcc.ie
- Information boards, plans and particulars were displayed in Firhouse Community Centre, as well as in County Hall, Tallaght and County Library, Tallaght for the full duration of the public consultation period.

Prior to the above, meetings had been held between South Dublin County Council staff and representatives of Firhouse Community Centre, Firhouse Carmel Football Club and the local elected members of the Council.

4. Evaluation of Proposed Development

The proposed development is in accordance with the zoning requirements as outlined in the South Dublin County Development Plan 2010-2016. The land is zoned Objective 'F' "To Preserve and Provide for Open Space and Recreational Amenities" and under this zoning educational use is 'Open for Consideration'.

Section 1.3.35 of the County Development Plan states "In the event of permission for development being granted on these lands [lands with established recreational uses], open space provision in excess of normal standards will be required to maintain the open character of such parts of the land as are considered necessary by the Council." The proposed development lands are set within an extensive open space network which links park land at Carrigwood and Carriglea with the Killininny Road sports grounds and open space at Killakee. It is considered that the open character of the area would not be compromised by the construction of the temporary schools as the link between all parklands would be maintained and substantial playing facilities would be regularised and improved.

The proposed development would be in keeping with the requirements of Policies SCR12 and SCR 13 of the South Dublin County Development Plan 2010-2016 which seek to "ensure that school and college sites are made available in accordance with the requirements of the relevant education authorities" and "that the Council will support and assist the Department of Education and Skills in ensuring the timely provision of school sites and to continue to coordinate with the Department in accordance with the Provision of Schools and the Planning System, a Code of Practice for Planning Authorities (2008)".

Policy T14 requires "sustainable forms of movement and the use of the street by pedestrians and cyclists and to promote permeable pedestrian and cyclist networks connecting to shops, community facilities, employment ares and desired places to go". The site of the proposed development is centrally located and would accommodate pupils from both the northern and southern sides of the Killininny Road offering sustainable forms of movement for both pedestrians and cyclists.

5. Overview of Submissions

5.1 Submissions

A total of 912 valid written submissions from 603 households were received by 4pm on Friday 26th July 2013. Each valid submission was assigned a unique reference number. 111 valid duplicate submissions were received (i.e. were submitted more than once); each of these duplicate submissions were incorporated under the original reference number for the person/body who made the submission and summarised accordingly. A list of all the persons/bodies that made the submissions is provided in Appendix 2 and Table 1 breaks down all types of submissions received.

5.2 Invalid Submissions

Two hundred and twenty four submissions could not be validated for the following reasons:

- 217 no. submissions did not provide sufficient address information or were rejected after the acknowledgment letters were returned to South Dublin County Council as 'refused', 'gone away' or 'unknown at this address'.
- 7 no. submissions were submitted on behalf of other parties without their permission

5.3 Submissions made on behalf of others

It is noted that a total of 541 submissions were signed and collected in advance of the commencement of the statutory public consultation period. These comprise a significant proportion of valid submissions. It is of concern that the signee could not have had the opportunity to inspect the details of the proposed development, as these had not yet been made public. Notwithstanding this likelihood, these submissions were considered valid because they were received during the statutory display period.

6. Overview of Issues Raised

6.1 Overview

The vast majority of submissions supported the principle of schools in the locality but objected to the use of the proposed site. The reasons stated for objecting to the proposed site are listed in Section 6. Ten submissions were received supporting the proposed development at this location and the break down of issues raised are listed in Section 6.2. One submission was received from the Dublin City Water Section detailing required works on the site in close proximity to the Dublin City water main. Section 6 links submitter's reference numbers to each of the issues they raised in their submissions. A list of the names of people/bodies that made submissions with assigned individual reference numbers is detailed in Appendix 2.

6.2 Circular Submissions

Three separate 'Circular' submissions were received before and during the public consultation period. In total 850, out of 912 valid submissions, including 842 written submissions and 8 emails, were made in this format:

A. Circular Submission 1 – 574 people made this submission

No objection to the new schools just their location. Objection to the site because:

- i) The proposed school development will result in an increased volume of traffic on already congested roads.
- ii) The proposed school development will result in an erosion of the green belt.

B. Circular Submission 2 – 157 people made this submission

- i) The proposed school development will take up almost 7 acres of green space and will have an impact on local amenity, traffic congestion and result in a reduction in playing fields.
- ii) Other undeveloped and previously approved sites should be considered for schools.

C. Circular Submission 3 – 119 people made this submission

Full support for additional schools in the area but objection to the proposed site as there are other more suitable sites such as the Victory Centre.

- i) The advert is misleading.
- ii) Loss of green amenity space.
- iii) A precedent would be set for further construction on green spaces.
- iv) Visual amenity would be lost affecting the value of homes.
- v) Increased traffic at a well-known accident black spot is unacceptable.

8. Manager's Responses to Issues Raised in Submissions:

8.1 Choice of site

In Autumn 2011 The Department of Education and Skills and the City and County Managers Association (CCMA) established a partnership with the aim of realising the provision of additional school accommodation urgently required to meet the forecasted demand for 45,000 primary school places by 2017/2018. South Dublin County Council's role in this inter-agency programme is to identify and acquire sites on behalf of the Department of Education and Skills. This role formally came into effect on June 1st 2012 under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Department of Education and Skills and the CCMA for the Acquisition of Sites for School Planning.

The Department of Education and Skills requested that South Dublin County Council identify sites for primary schools in at least six locations in the County, including Firhouse. This request is based on demographic projections derived from census data, the pattern of school enrolments and data from the Department of Social and Community Affairs as well as a local survey and school establishment process that included three applications in relation to the Firhouse area, two of which were successful. The Council has no role in relation to school establishment or patronage and the Department's requirement to provide sites for school accommodation in the Firhouse area was reiterated to the Council, just prior to the commencement of the Part 8 public display process.

The site subject to this Part 8 proposed development is located to the south of the established residential areas of Carriglea and Carrigwood and is bounded to the north by Ballycullen Drive and to the south by Killinniny Road. An existing football pitch is located to the east of the site and the Firhouse Community Centre is located to the west. Further residential areas, including Woodstown, Wood Dale, Hunters Wood and Oldcourt are located to the south of Killinniny Road. The site is centrally located in the Firhouse-Ballycullen area and is within 1km of almost all existing houses, maximising the potential for walking and cycling to the schools.

The subject site forms the most westerly portion of a larger 2.3 ha site at Killinniny Road that the Department of Educations and Skills has sought to permanently acquire from the Council. Such an acquisition would be subject to a land disposal by the Council under a separate procedure, Section 183 of the Planning and Development Act, (2000, as amended). The Part 8 proposed development site is a grassed area that is subject to occasional use, but is generally underutilised in an area that is well served with public open space. A footpath dissects the open space and provides a pedestrian link between Ballycullen Drive and Killinniny Road. The larger potential disposal site includes an established football pitch leased to a local club that will be relocated as part of any future permanent school development.

In November 2012 the Department of Education and Skills confirmed the number of schools required to serve this area as 2 no. 16 classroom schools and advised that there is a requirement for temporary accommodation to be in place by September 2013. That is not now possible and the Department of Education and Skills has secured short-term temporary accommodation for the initial school intake at local community centres.

Following consultation with local elected members prior to public display of the Part 8 proposal, further details in relation to the need for schools at this location were submitted to South Dublin County Council by the Department of Education and Skills. This report sets out that given the historic increase in enrolment numbers and predicted future increases based on the number of children of pre-school age living in the area, the Department of Education and Skills considers that the establishment of new schools is essential in the area to cater for this increase and also to add to the choice of school type available to parents.

The geographic distribution of the existing primary schools across the overall area is also relevant. A total of eleven primary schools are situated in the Oldbawn area while there are just three primary schools located in Firhouse, serving a similar population of 5-12 year old children. It is the Department's assessment that the projected demand for increased pupil places could not be catered for by the three existing schools in the Firhouse area and therefore the data suggests that new schools should be located within this particular geographic area.

8.2 Alternative Sites

The Department of Education and Skills originally requested that a site be acquired to accommodate 1 no. 16 classroom school in Firhouse/Oldbawn. In November 2012 the Department revised the request to accommodate 2 no. primary schools and the preferred option was in a campus arrangement. The Department requires 1.5-1.6 hectares for a primary school and approximately 2.2ha to accommodate 2 no. schools within a campus. The Department also requires accommodation for 2 no. temporary schools to be in place by September 2013. In order to effectively manage cost outlays and disruption SDCC sought to find a site whereby the temporary accommodation could be located and satisfy the requirements of the Department.

Six site options were evaluated¹. The following table and corresponding map details the options and comments on their various attributes.

Site	Assessment
1	A 2.9 hectare site owned by SDCC. Upon further assessment this site was not progressed due to potential flood risk issues associated with the site
2	A 2.19 hectare site that is privately owned. This site was shortlisted and a valuation was obtained for its possible acquisition. Upon further assessment of the future development of the wider area, the Department of Education and Skills requested that this site continue to be reserved for the planned development of Ballycullen. Further analysis demonstrated that Site 6 at Killininny Road / Ballycullen Drive is located centrally within the catchment of the required school places, whereas Site 2 is located on the periphery.
3	A 1 hectare site that is privately owned. This site was not progressed due to a recent grant of permission for a supermarket and because the site size was below the Department's minimum requirement.
4	A 1 hectare site that is owned by SDCC. This site was not progressed as Site 6 offered a viable option for a 2 school campus.
5	A 2.5 hectare site owned by SDCC. This site was not progressed due to the configuration being narrower than site 6 which would compromise the potential for school development; the third party ownership of a narrow strip of the site along the entire length of Ballycullen Drive which would compromise access; and the proposed community uses (all weather pitches) on the site.
6	A 2.2 hectare site owned by SDCC (within a larger landholding) with access from Ballycullen Drive and Killininny Road. This is the Department's preferred site that is subject to this Part 8 proposed development.



¹ Note additional sites were assessed following Part 8 public consultation and assessment of all sites is contained in the *Firhouse School Site Identification and Acquisition Process Report*, October 2014.

8.3 Need for School

The historic enrolment numbers in this area indicate that the student population at primary level has grown significantly over the past decade from 3,469 pupils to 4,225 per annum. Child benefit statistics indicate that the numbers enrolling at junior infant level over the next number of years is going to grow. The tables below show the current enrolment in the area in each primary class group. As can be seen in Table 1, the numbers in the junior classes are much higher than in the senior classes and as these larger class groups feed up through the system additional accommodation will be required. Table 2 shows the predicted enrolment in each class group over the next four years indicating a growth in enrolments from 4,636 to 5,408. This growth is equivalent to an additional 38 classrooms at a pupil teacher ratio of 28:1.

Therefore given the historic enrolment numbers increase and the predicted future increases based on the numbers of children in the pre-school age groups living in the area the Department of Education and Skills considers that new schools are essential in the area to cater for this increase and to add to the choice of school type available to parents.

8.4 Use of Open Space/New Playground

There was significant support for a school in the area provided that the existing playing pitches and open space would not be jeopardised. There is an existing football pitch to the east of the subject site and this would not be affected by the Part 8 proposed development. Access between this pitch and the football club, which is based in the Firhouse Community Centre to the west of the subject site, would be maintained. The existing hedgerow and pedestrian gate onto Killinniny Road, together with the gas main and watermain wayleaves, all of which are located within the vicinity of the proposed site, would not be affected by this proposal.

The Part 8 proposal provides for the development of a playground on the site of the temporary schools following their relocation to a permanent site, within a four year period. Although there is an abundance of open space and pocket parks in the vicinity of the subject site, there is a dearth of play facilities for young children and this proposal aims to address this situation.


On the full realisation of the Part 8 proposed development the Firhouse/Ballycullen community would benefit from the upgrading and consolidation of the existing open space through the construction of a new playground and a car parking area off the Killinniny Road to serve the existing pitches and community buildings in the vicinity.

8.5 Road/Pedestrian Safety:

According to the Road Safety Authority statistics, since 2005 there has been one minor traffic accident reported on Ballycullen Drive and none in the immediate area of the proposed school. There is a significant amount of traffic calming in the vicinity of the school and the traffic speeds are considered to be very low.

8.6 Accessibility/Reduction in use of motor Vehicle

At present children are leaving the area to attend schools a significant distance from their homes necessitating multiple car movements that maybe rendered unnecessary if the school was located in close proximity to their homes. This would in turn enable increased walking and cycling to the schools supporting national, county and local policies of sustainable development. Map 2 indicates the location of the proposed development site and the wide catchment area within the 800m walking band covering residential areas to both the north and south of the Killininny Road.

8.7 Traffic congestion

The drop-off car parking is to be located on the Killinney Road, in order to reduce traffic congestion on Ballycullen Road. The temporary schools are small and it is not considered that they will significantly increase traffic congestion in the area.

It is noted that eight submissions supported the location of the school because it would enable families from both sides of the Killinniny Road to walk to school helping to reduce traffic congestion.

8.8 Public parking

The proposed dedicated public car parking facility off Killinniny Road will improve accessibility to the open space and proposed playground and will underpin and support existing sports facilities in the area.

8.9 Public Consultation

A comprehensive public consultation took place comprising:

- Numerous meetings with local elected members
- Presentations to Area Committees
- Public displays at local venues including the Firhouse Community Centre,
 Tallaght Library and Tallaght Civic Offices
- Meetings with local community organisations
- Information uploaded onto SDCC website
- A public notice advertised in the local press

8.10 Temporary/Permanent Nature of the School

There is an established need for permanent schools in this area. Two new primary schools for Firhouse opened in September 2013 and are being facilitated in temporary accommodation in the Firhouse Community Centre and the Tymon Bawn Community Centre. This temporary arrangement is not tenable for the future long-term viability of the schools, and it is no longer an option as temporary accommodation for the schools beyond this academic year. This Part 8 would enable the provision of temporary school accommodation for a period of up to 4 years, until such time as permanent buildings are constructed. Any further proposals for permanent schools that would require the disposal of South Dublin County Council owned land would be subject to a separate Section 183 procedure.

8.11 Community Development Plan, Ministerial Guidelines and Technical Guidance Document.

This proposed development has been made in accordance with the Ministerial Guidelines 'The Provision of Schools and the Planning System: A code of Practice for Planning Authorities (July 2008)' and the Department of Education and Science Techical Guidance Document (TGD-025): 'Identification and Suitability Assessment of Sites for Primary Schools'.

The proposed development is in accordance with the South Dublin County Development Plan 2010-2016. The land is zoned Objective 'F' "To Preserve and Provide for Open Space and Recreational Amenities". Educational use is 'Open for Consideration' within this zoning.

Based on established school need at this location and after a thorough evaluation of all possible sites in the area and taking into consideration the Zoning Objective on the site it is considered that the substantial open space provision along Killininny Road and its open character would not be compromised by the proposed development and would not be contrary to the County Development Plan 2010-2016.


9. Recommendation:

South Dublin County Council has an obligation under the Memoranum of Understanding to cooperate with the Department of Education and Skills in the acquisition of sites suitable for the construction and development of buildings for educational purposes. It is also the Policy SCR12 of the Council, as stated in the South Dublin County Development Plan 2010-2016, "to ensure that school and college sites are made available in accordance with the requirements of the relevant education authorities" and Policy SCR13 of the same Plan states "the Council will support and assist the Department of Education and Skills in ensuring the timely provision of school sites and to continue to co-ordinate with the Department in accordance with the Provision of Schools and the Planning System, a Code of Practice for Planning Authorities (2008)".


There is an established need for schools at this location; historic enrolment figures signal that significant growth has taken place over the past decade and recently complied data of children in the pre-school age groups indicates further substantial growth. It is considered necessary to provide schools for the growing youthful population and to offer choices in the school types made available to parents living within Firhouse. An assessment of all possible sites for the location of the temporary schools in the area was undertaken and the proposed development site was considered to be the must suitable option. This Part 8 proposal supports the Department of Education and Skills in providing educational facilities where they are required. The final realisation of the Part 8 proposal will also result in the development of a children's play area, making a significant contribution to existing community facilities and the proposed public car parking will strengthen and underpin the existing sporting and leisure facilities in the environs. It is therefore recommended that the proposed development should be proceeded with as proposed.


