I am writing in response to your recent letter concerning the request to provide a post box in the Boot Road/Rockfield Drive/Commons Road area of Clondalkin in Dublin 22.

I see that a detailed assessment of the posting needs in the Clondalkin area was carried out recently in response to a query we received in November from you on the same subject.

As outlined in our response, on the 21st of November 2014, it was reported that there was a specific box on Boot Road itself which was removed many years ago and a new box was installed at the junction of New Road and Saint Brigid's Road - which is only 350 metres from the original site.

We will not be providing additional boxes in the Boot Road area as there are two boxes in the vicinity. One, as referred to above and the other is in Clondalkin Village.

We have no reports of capacity issues at either of the existing post boxes which are deemed sufficient for the posting needs of the immediate area.
