Re: Amended Motion Passed at Meeting of South Dublin County Council (M11/1114)

Dear Minister Kelly,

The following amended motion was Passed at the meeting of South Dublin County Council held on 10th November 2014:-

"That the Chief Executive seeks immediate suspension of installation of water meters within the County because the supply is unsafe due to Irish Water's failure to supply tamper-proof meters to each household, and asks that the consultants who were paid €185 million are named and excluded from supplying consultancy services to the Department of the Environment or any other government departments in future. Residents are being asked to pay for a food source which is open to contamination. You cannot buy a jar of pasta sauce without a tamper-proof lid on it so the residents of this County deserve the same, most basis safety standard in relation to their water supply."
