Re: Council motion passed on section 37.1 Equality Act 1998

Dear Mr O'Neill

Mr Aodhán Ó Ríordáin TD, Minister of State for New Communities, Culture and Equality has asked me to reply to your letter dated 15th December, 2014 regarding the text of a motion passed recently by South Dublin County Council on section 37.1 of the Employment Equality Act 1998.

While not specific to them, the Minister of State accepts that section 37.1 impacts particularly on LGBT people and its provision has operated in a way that is not a fair balancing on the right to freedom on the one hand, and the rights of persons to non-discrimination in employment on the other.

As announced previously, the Government accepts the principle of the Employment Equality (Amendment) (No.2) bill currently before the Seanad to better balance the right of employees to protection in this area and will be tabling a number of amendments to improve this Private Member's Bill when the debate resumes in the new year.
