Record of Executive Business and Chief Executive's Order

Payment for Anti-litter and Anti-graffiti Awareness grant scheme 2014

As part of the Council's anti-litter and anti-graffiti awareness grant scheme 2014, funding is provided to organisations to carry out anti-litter and anti-graffiti awareness initiatives in South Dublin County.

Accordingly, community and environmental groups which carry out voluntary initiatives that focus on involving schools and young people in anti-litter and anti-graffiti projects were requested, via placement of advertisements in the local media, to submit proposals for the anti-litter and anti-graffiti awareness grant scheme 2014.

This grant scheme is carried out in conjunction with the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government. The Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government provide 70% (€33,050) of the funding and South Dublin County Council provide 30% (€14,164.29) of the funding.

A list of the submissions from SDCC, community and environmental groups was submitted to the Department of Environment, Community and Local Government for approval (see appendix 1)(Signed copy saved on file). Approval was received via an email (see appendix 2) from the Department of Environment on the 16th July, 2014, for all the submitted projects. Following receipt of approval from the Department of Environment, South Dublin County Council sent a letter to the Department claiming the grant amount of €33,050 on the 29th July 2014, (see appendix 3).

Accordingly, I recommend payment in the sum of €47,214.29 in respect of the anti-litter and anti-graffiti awareness grant scheme (€33,050 of which is provided by the DECLG) to fund the projects listed in appendix 1.



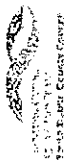
