I wish to make an objection against the proposed South Dublin County Council/Cluid development at Tay Lane, Rathcoole for the following reasons:-

1. The demise of the Taffee family business which has been in operation for over 100 years. We feel that no one should be put out of business after all their hard work over the last decades.
2. We feel in this small rural community a development like this is not suitable and will take away the landscape and community spirit of the whole area. These developments integrate much better in a larger community because they have the population to carry it.
3. The number of Halting/Cluid developments in the area will be too high. Three between Rathcoole and Newcastle within a 2 mile radius and not to mention the developments in Pollyhops, Celbridge, Blackchurch and many more in the area.
4. The proposed site is located on a very dangerous bend which will increase the chance of a very dangerous accident or possibly loss of life.
5. There is no site notice located on the site for planning reasons.
6. The value of our house will decrease immediately.
7. The settled community is being discriminated against due to the fact that no sewage has ever been supplied for the existing residents on Tay Lane. We as a household have been put to huge expense facilitating biocycles etc., yet this development will have an immediate sewage line supplied.
