GLENVIEW PARK

Glenview Park

- Prunus padus 'Watereri' (Cherry)
- Quercus robur (Oak)
- Beech hedge
- Low maintenance ornamental shrub planting
- Precast paving with limestone strips

- Trim and tidy existing trees
- Low maintenance ornamental shrub planting
- Replace kissing gates with stainless steel bollards
- Stylized grass mounding
- Hedgerow

- Remove poplars, retain other good quality specimen trees, add more trees
- Bulb planting
- Prunus padus 'Watereri' (Cherry)
- Spiral mounding and planting to roundabout, Oak with ogham stones with lighting

- Upgrade existing hedge, and fill in gaps
- Remove self seeded trees
- Low maintenance ornamental shrub planting

Stylized grass mounding

- Galvanized steel planter
- 'Toucan' shared pedestrian and cyclist crossing
- Precast paving with limestone strips
