Sports Capital Grant Projects:

A number of projects are being delivered via the Sports Capital Grants programme which result in the delivery of recreational facilities within public open space; usually in conjunction with local

- Upgrade of Athletics track at Lucan
- Provision of All Weather Pitch at Lucan
