Dear Mayor,

At a meeting of the County Council held on Monday 11th December, 2017 the following Motion was PASSED by the Members:

"That Fingal County Council will contact the Minister for the Environment and the Mayors of all three other Dublin local authorities to express our concern at the Dublin City Manager's recent declaration that it is his intention to introduce an 'Infinity Congestion Charge' by blocking off routes for cars to access or use the city centre, and at the recent extension of his 18mph speed limits across large swathes of the city. While this Council supports increasing choice of travel mode for commuters through the extension of public transport and cycle routes, we recognise that these modes are not suitable for all and that this support for choices should not mean that an absolutist anti car ideology is allowed to eliminate car journeys as an option in the city."
