Facilities at Clonburris Sports Campus should be focused on mixed use playing pitches suitable for full size or small sized games of different codes shared between schools and the wider community and should accommodate as a minimum changing rooms with toilets and secure storage space for sports equipment, a safe pedestrian bridge crossing over the Outer Ring Road.
