See below motion that was passed by the Lucan Area Committee Meeting members.

"That this Committee writes to Dublin Bus, pending a requested sit down meeting on related issues, seeking additional morning peak hour buses to be put on the route servicing Willsbrook bus stop towards the city centre from 7-9am as hundreds of people have been left stranded for more than 45 minutes on different days due to full buses passing commuters at this location on a regular basis."

As you can see from the motion, an invitation was previously issued to attend one of the ACMs to discuss transport issues in the Lucan/Palmerstown area. I would be grateful if you could confirm if you will be in a position to attend such a meeting.

Hi John,

At the January Lucan Area Committee Meeting, the following motions were passed by the members:-

"That this Committee writes to Dublin Bus requesting a meeting in relation to bus services in the electoral area, in particular inadequate peak time 25, 25A, 25B services to Lucan/Adamstown and additional capacity problems caused by the purchase of new buses which has resulted in a reduction in legal loads of 10 passengers per bus, although longer buses are available to purchase; and furthermore to discuss plans to ensure provision of orbital bus routes servicing the Outer Ring Road in advance of any construction at Clonburris SDZ."

**Also**

"That the Chief Executive write to Dublin Bus asking (1) why it is that the proposed extension of the 26 Bus to the Liffey Valley Shopping Centre did not take place as promised/indicated and to ask for a firm date when it is to happen, and (2) To request that the 18 Bus display "Palmerstown Village" as its destination rather than of Old Lucan Road?"
