At the meeting of the Clondalkin Area Committee held on 21st November, 2018, the following Motion was adopted and approved by the Members:


Cathaoirleach's Business

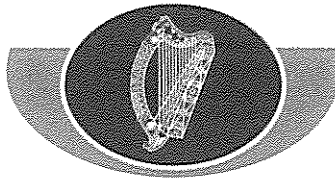
