

### Draft Traveller Accommodation Programme 2019-2024


- Draft programme published 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019
  National/local press, <u>www.sdcc.ie</u> & Consultation Portal
- Two-month period for submissions on draft programme
- Considered by LTACC
- Closing date for submissions was 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019.

## Submissions:

115 submissions received during consultation period:

- 99 submissions in respect of indicative sites for Traveller Accommodation at Newcastle, Bustyhill, Steelstown, Windmill Hill/Blackchurch
- 9 submissions relating to proposals for the provision of Traveller Accommodation in Rathcoole.
- 1 submission on proposed Traveller Accommodation in Shackleton Estate in Adamstown
- 6 other submissions relating to various Traveller accommodation, cultural and other issues

#### • Indicative Future Locations:

Baldonnell / Newcastle / Peamount / Steelstown / Bustyhill / Blackchurch / Brittas

## Traveller Accommodation Programme 2019-2024

- New TAP will cover 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
- Largely previously identified sites / areas
- One additional site added to draft
- Increasing preference for standard social housing
- All indigenous families & preferences factored into plan
- Indicative locations can cater for emerging need / future family formations over plan timeframe
- Latest date for adoption by Council is 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2019
