Dear Ms Reilly

The provision of lighting at bus shelters is dependent on the availability of a separate electricity supply nearby. As you will appreciate the installation costs are higher the greater the distance between the electricity supply point and the bus shelter.

In that regard it is also important to note that it is not possible to connect into the street light supply due to the restrictions imposed under energy regulation legislation.

However, perhaps you could supply a list of the bus shelter locations in question for further consideration. In each case we would need the bus stop number i.e. a 3 or 4 digit number as displayed at the bus stop.

Any reply received will be circulated to the members of the committee at the next meeting and will be available to the public as part of the minutes of the meeting.

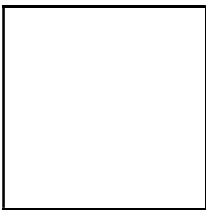
