Re: Motion from January Meeting of the Lucan/Palmerstown/Fonthill Area Committee

Dear Ms. Brennan,

I refer to your correspondence of 30 January on behalf of the Lucan/Palmerstown/Fonthill Area Committee in relation to Item 68770 “*non-disabled car parking at Adamstown train station*”.

It is intended that the parking provision at Adamstown Train Station will be developed in accordance with the proposals set out in the adopted Planning Scheme for the Adamstown Strategic Development Zone. The Planning Scheme provides for a Park and Ride facility to be constructed as part of the District Centre development adjacent to the Station. However, given the overall principles guiding the Adamstown Strategic Development Zone, access to the train station is expected to be predominately by walking and cycling modes.

While the NTA have no plans at present to increase the level of parking provision at this station, the build-out of the District Centre area will be required to consider the development of the Park and Ride facility as specified in the Planning Scheme.
