The free one-hour concerts aim to animate local towns and districts so that communities can feel the benefits of live music something that has been missed by many during the last 18 months

The aim of the Local Live Performance South Dublin County programme is to assist producers, promoters and venues in providing support for people in an industry which has suffered so much over the past 18 months. Speaking to The Echo, one of the artists who will be performing at the concerts is singer songwriter Jason Rankin, who says he is "delighted" to be back performing at live events. "I am so thankful to be part of the concerts - as soon as I heard about it I said yes straight away, and I imagine that everyone else was the same
