'The Revival of Live'

LOCAL communities will have the opportunity to experience a series of free outdoor live concerts as 'The Revival of Live' performances will take place in open-air settings during this August and September.

'Seó Beo Arís: The Revival of Live' kicked off on August 8 with several outdoor live performances taking place in Lucan and Rathfarnham curated by Artscope's Caroline Wynne, Martin Tourish and Simon Morgan in association with South Dublin County Council.

The free one-hour concerts aim to animate local towns and districts so that communities can feel the benefits of live music – something that has been missed by many during the last 18 months.

The aim of the Local Live Performance South Dublin County programme is to assist producers, promoters and venues in providing support for people in an industry which has suffered so much over the past 18 months.

Speaking to *The Echo*, one of the artists who will be performing at the concerts is singer songwriter Jason Rankin, who says he is "delighted" to be back performing at live events.

"I am so thankful to be part of the concerts – as soon as I heard about it I said yes straight away, and I imagine that everyone else was the same because we are all just itching to get back and perform in front of

people and see crowds of people looking back at you.

"It was very weird to just stop everything during the pandemic, but it is great to be back. With the Revival of Live there is so many events for different genres. You have the singer songwriter genre, jazz, modern, contemporary, classical you name it – they really have hit the nail on the head."

The funding obtained by Artscope will be used to support employment and wellbeing in the commercial arts and culture sectors through the provision of live performances by engaging the services of locally based

professional artists, musicians, crew and other staff members involved in live performances.

The concerts will take place in the grounds of Lucan Community College at Esker Drive, Lucan, Co. Dublin and Rathfarnham Castle Park over four weekends in August and into September.

Commencing on Sunday, August 8 at 6.00pm in Lucan, with a line-up of performers from the Lucan Creative Collective both Lucan and Rathfarnham will play host to more than 100 individuals all involved professionally in the arts.

Other stages will include the

best of traditional music from across Ireland playing a range of different genres. For children and families attending there will also be some works commissioned by South Dublin County Council for Ruailie Buaille – Lucan Children's Music Festival 2021 performed live.

Public health and safety measures will be in place at the concerts and masks are mandatory on arrival at the concert and can only be removed when you are in your designated seat.

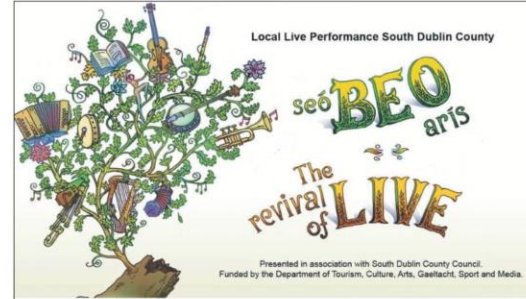

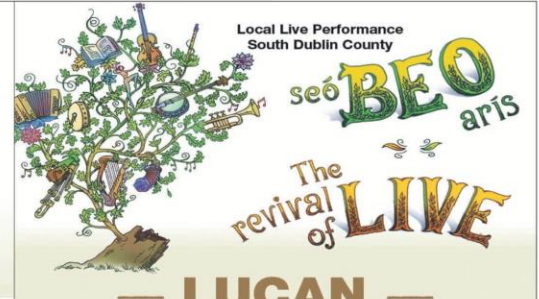

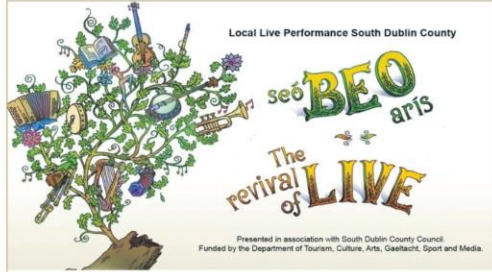

JERRY FISH BRINGS LIVE MUSIC BACK TO LIVE AT THE STADIUM

Live music returns to Dublin with indie legend and ringmaster of exceptional renown Jerry Fish headlining Live at the Stadium: a one-night only event at the Stadium in Tallaght on Thursday 2nd September 2021. The Meteor award-winning Jerry Fish is known to legions of music fans in Ireland as the former lead singer of An Emotional Fish and creator of The Jerry Fish Electric Sideshow at Electric Picnic.

With fans of music everywhere deprived of live music since the onset of Covid, this will be the first live music gig in Tallaght Stadium since the start of the pandemic. Speaking about the gig, Jerry

said: "The lack of live music during the pandemic and so many lockdowns has been extremely tough for both music lovers and musicians alike, we are bursting with musical joy that needs to be heard and experienced by a live audience. We are going to give Tallaght Stadium a night to remember."

With support on the night from local bands Arthur and Jazzabelles; Live at the Stadium promises to be a memorable one!

Jazzabelles take to the live stage

AN ALL-FEMALE jazz band are set to take to the stage in Tallaght Stadium next month, with creative and inventive takes on jazz standards.

The Jazzabelles are an eight-piece jazz band who decided to join forces during the pandemic, after having previously attended jamming sessions together over the years.

Their performance at Live at the Stadium in Tallaght Stadium on September 2 – which will be headlined by Jerry Fish and the Mudbug Club – will be the third time the band will perform live together.

Explaining how the band came to be, Jazzabelle member Enid Conaghan, who grew up in Walkinstown and lives in Clondalkin, told *The Echo*: "We all knew each other from jamming in the jazz community in Dublin.

"Last year, I organised some all-female jazz jams and I found that we were a little underrepresented, and I wanted to encourage women to be proactive in joining in with jazz jams.

"I formed the Jazzabelles during lockdown, and we started to get together in May, with the help of Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, and we'd play beside the Orangerie in Marlay Park on Saturdays."

The group recently played their second ever gig in Áras Chrónáin in Clondalkin, and their performances of 'Autumn Leaves' and 'Blue Bossa' have gone down a storm.

"We always add a twist or our own special arrangement," explained Enid. "It's a lovely process, and it's really lovely to see these things developing."

Overall, Enid said the aim of the Jazzabelles is to encourage women in jazz "to mentor and empower each other, and lose the impostor syndrome"

When asked how the band feels about their upcoming performance at Tallaght Stadium, Enid said: "We're beyond excited, we're just delighted.

"It's an honour to be picked for this, and we're good to go. We are all giggling

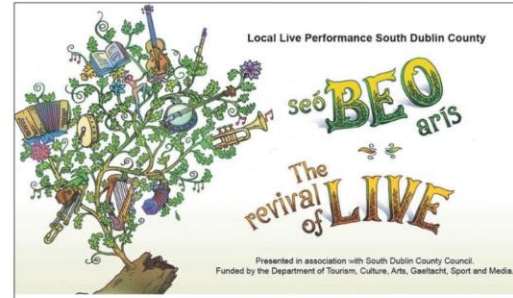
musicians and part of other bands so we're all well used to gigging.

"It's what we love doing – sharing music and including the audience, and helping it to be a relatable experience for them."
