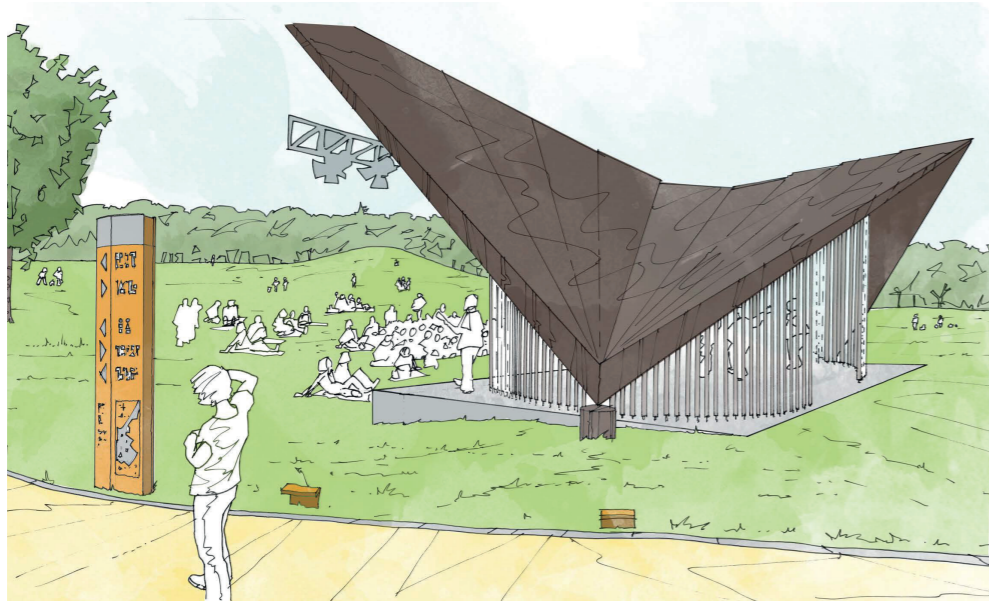

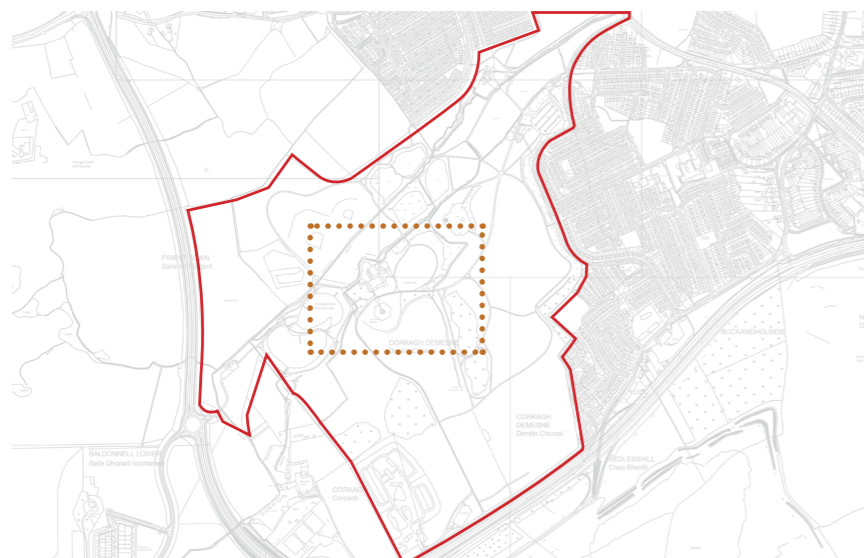
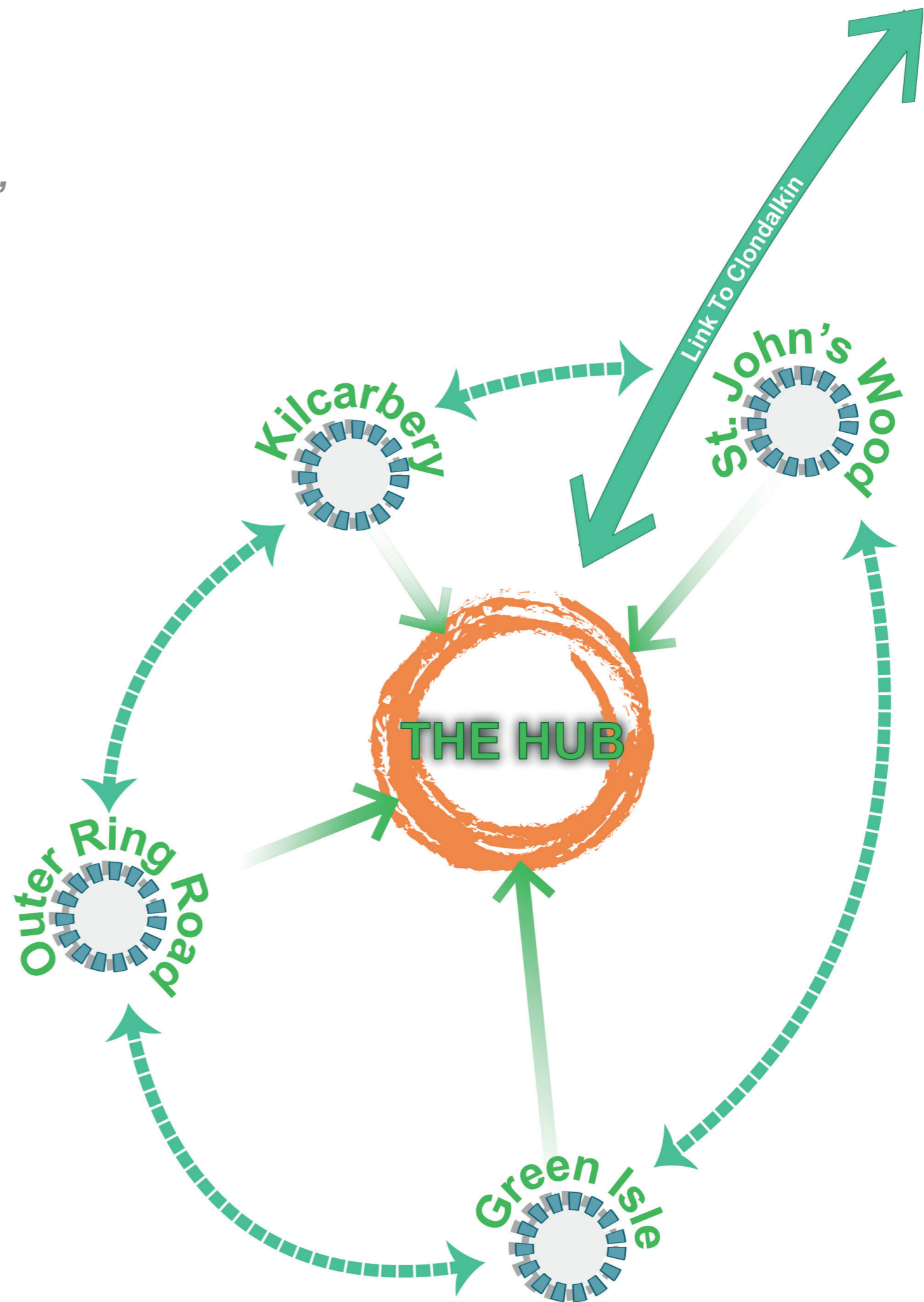

'defining a new centre for Corkagh Park'

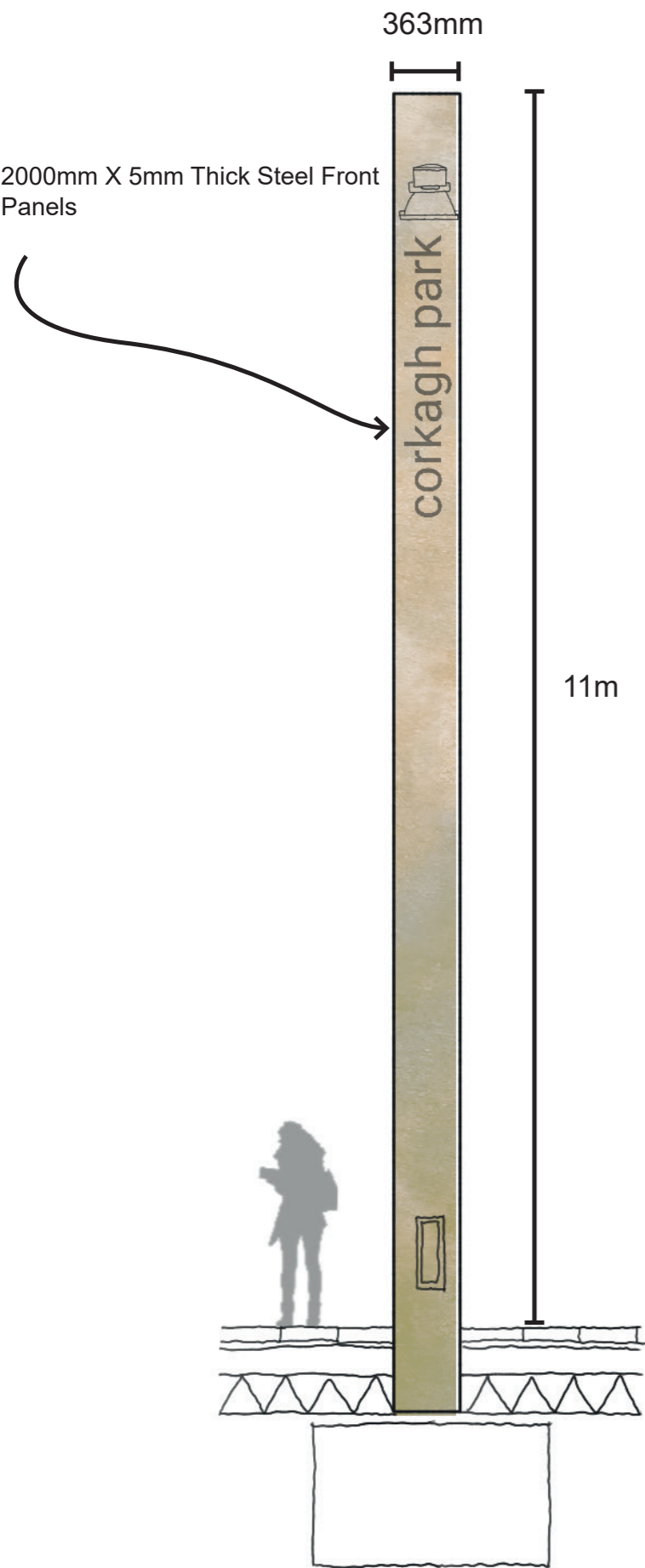
- Creating a new Events Space and Café north of the Rose Garden.

- Enhancements to walking and cycling infrastructure.



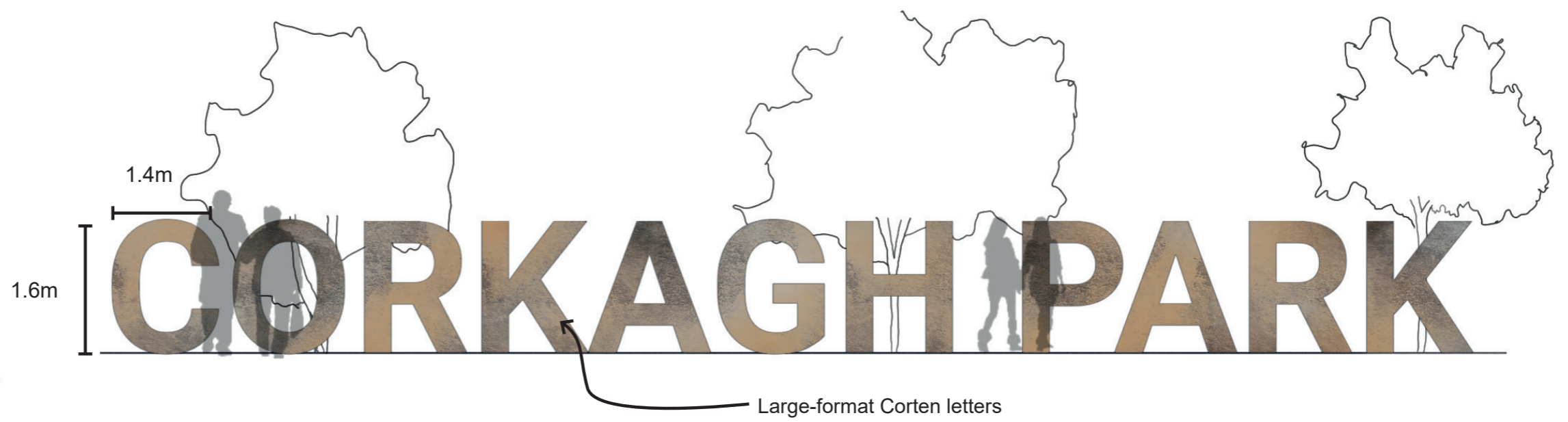

To be manufactured as 10 to 50mm plates (subject to detail design.)

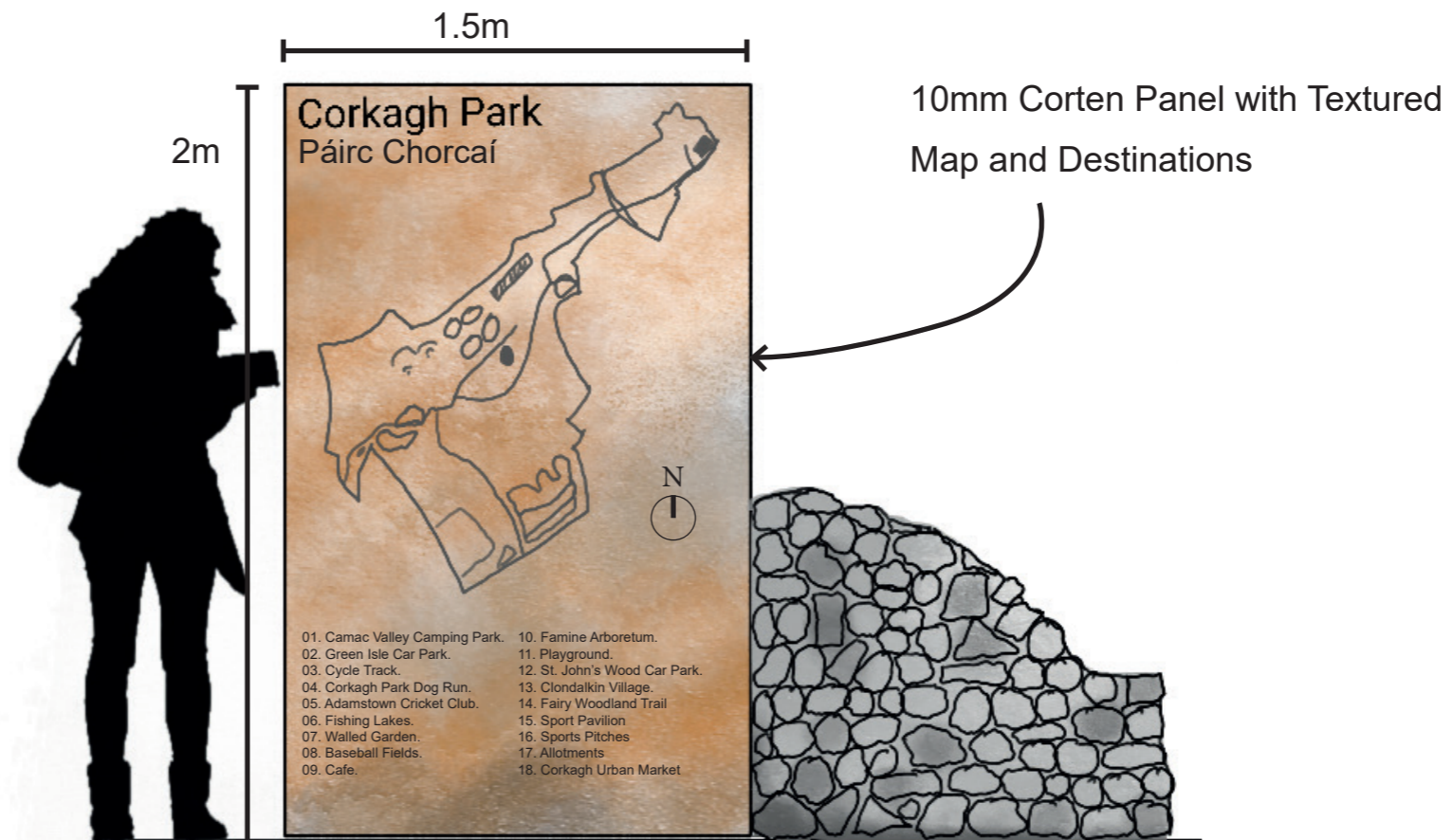
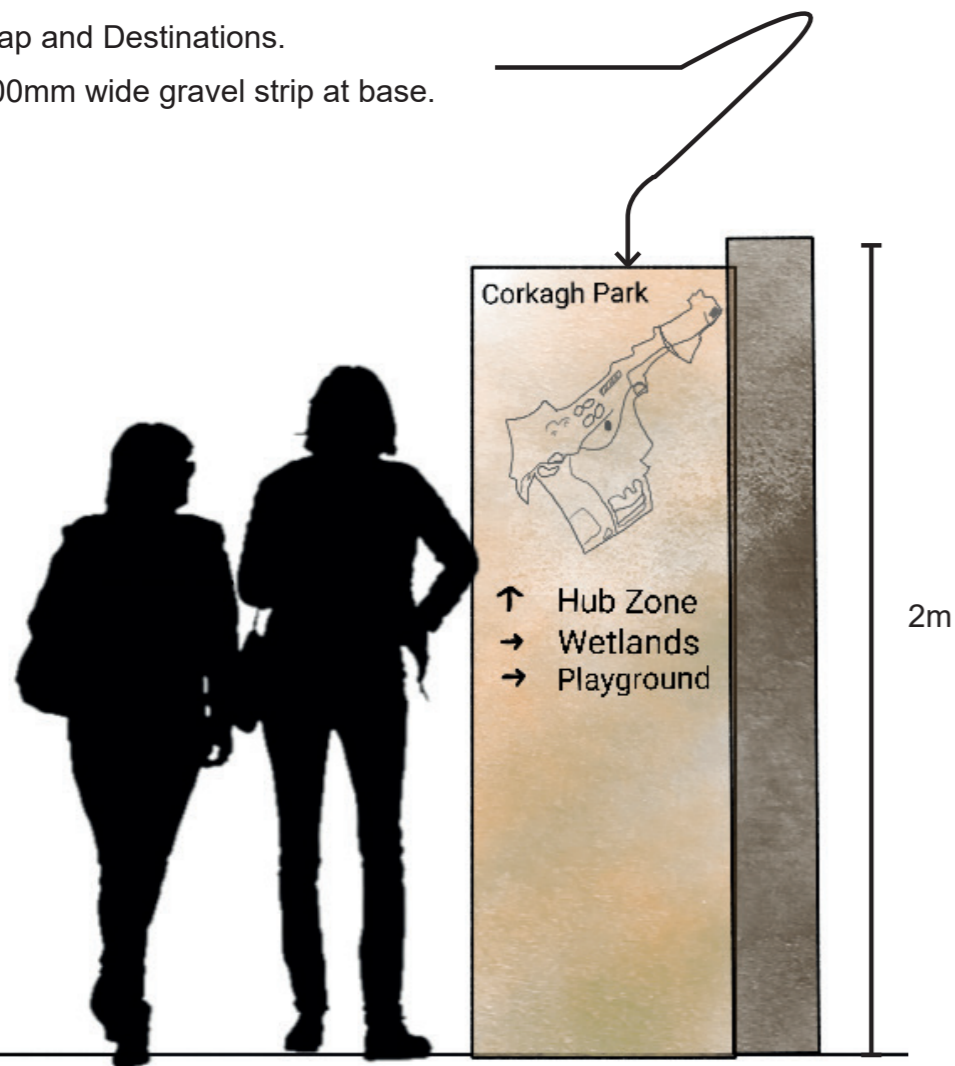

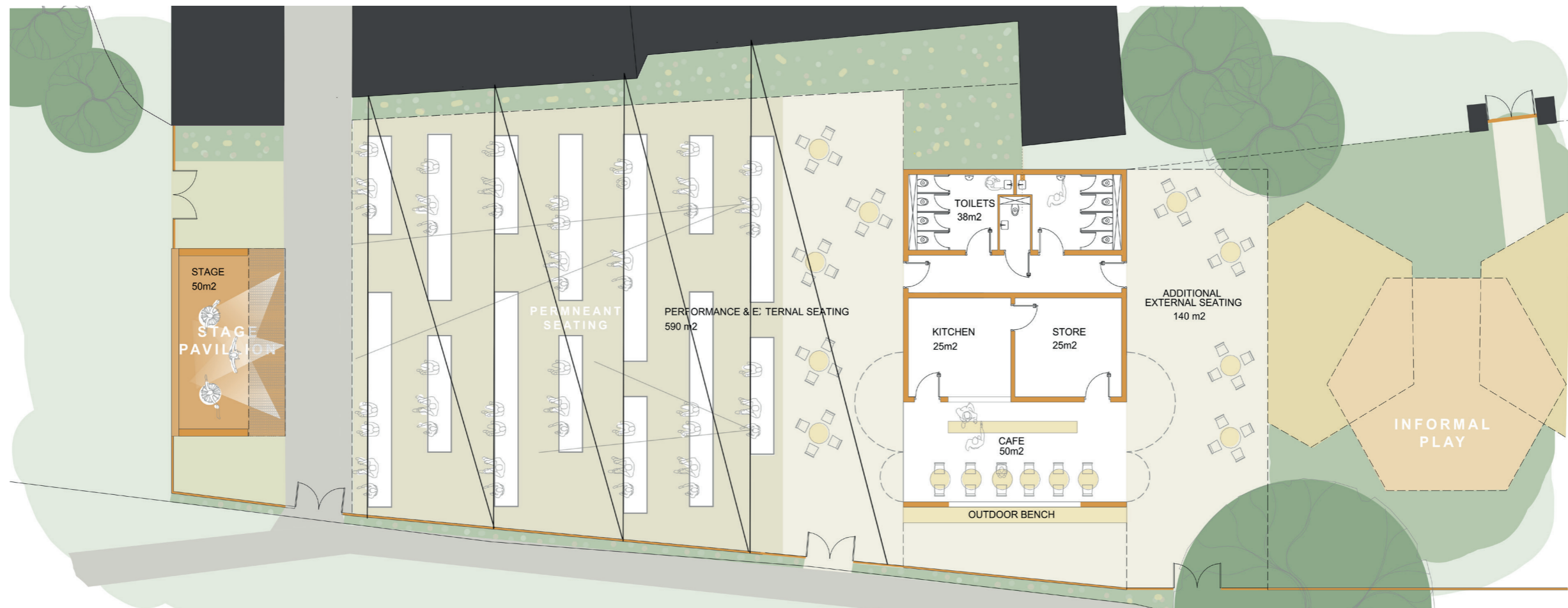

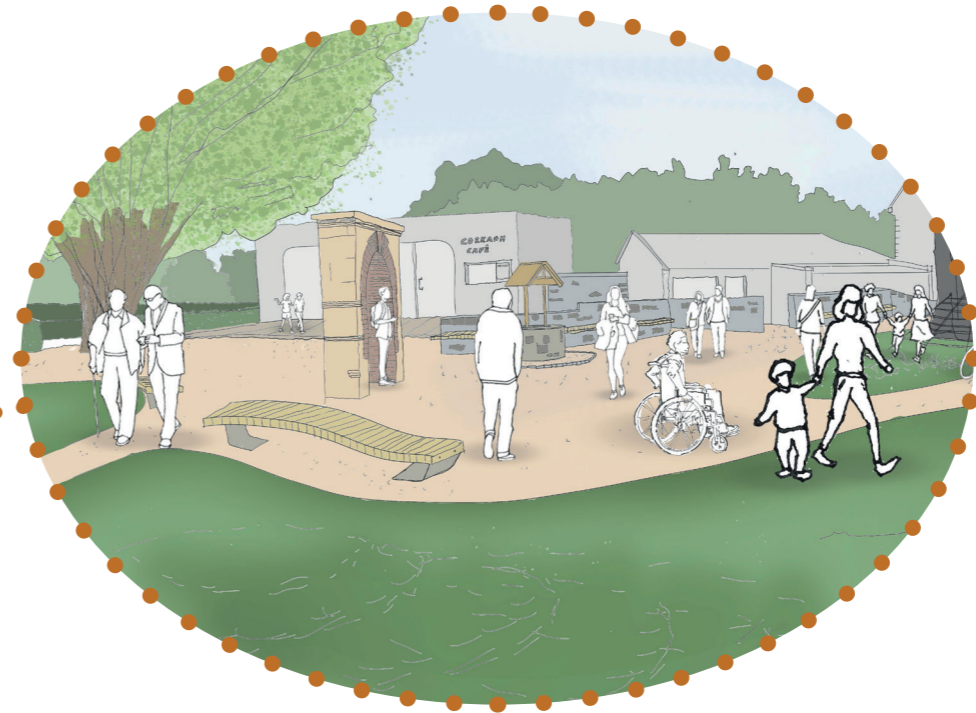

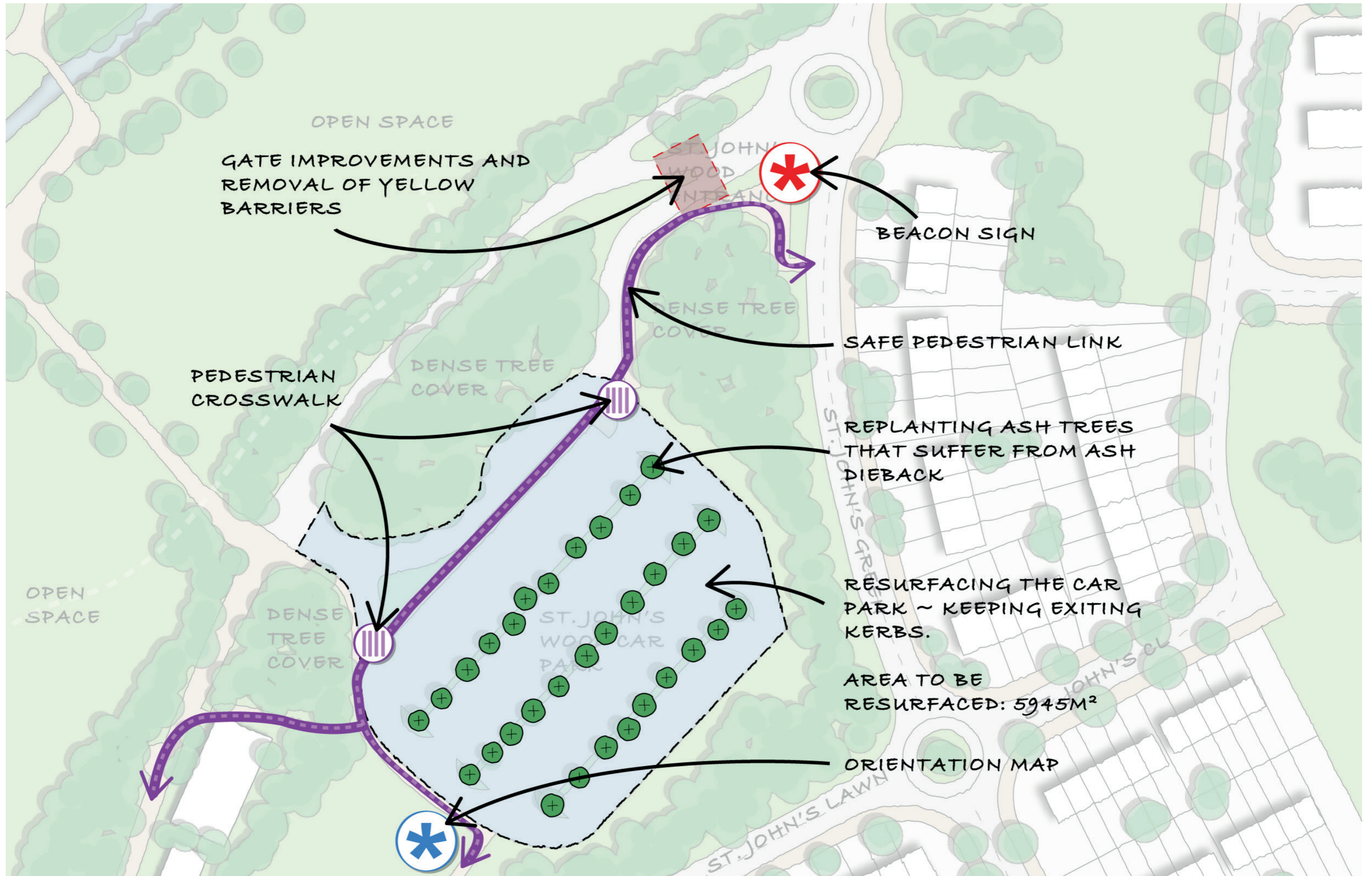

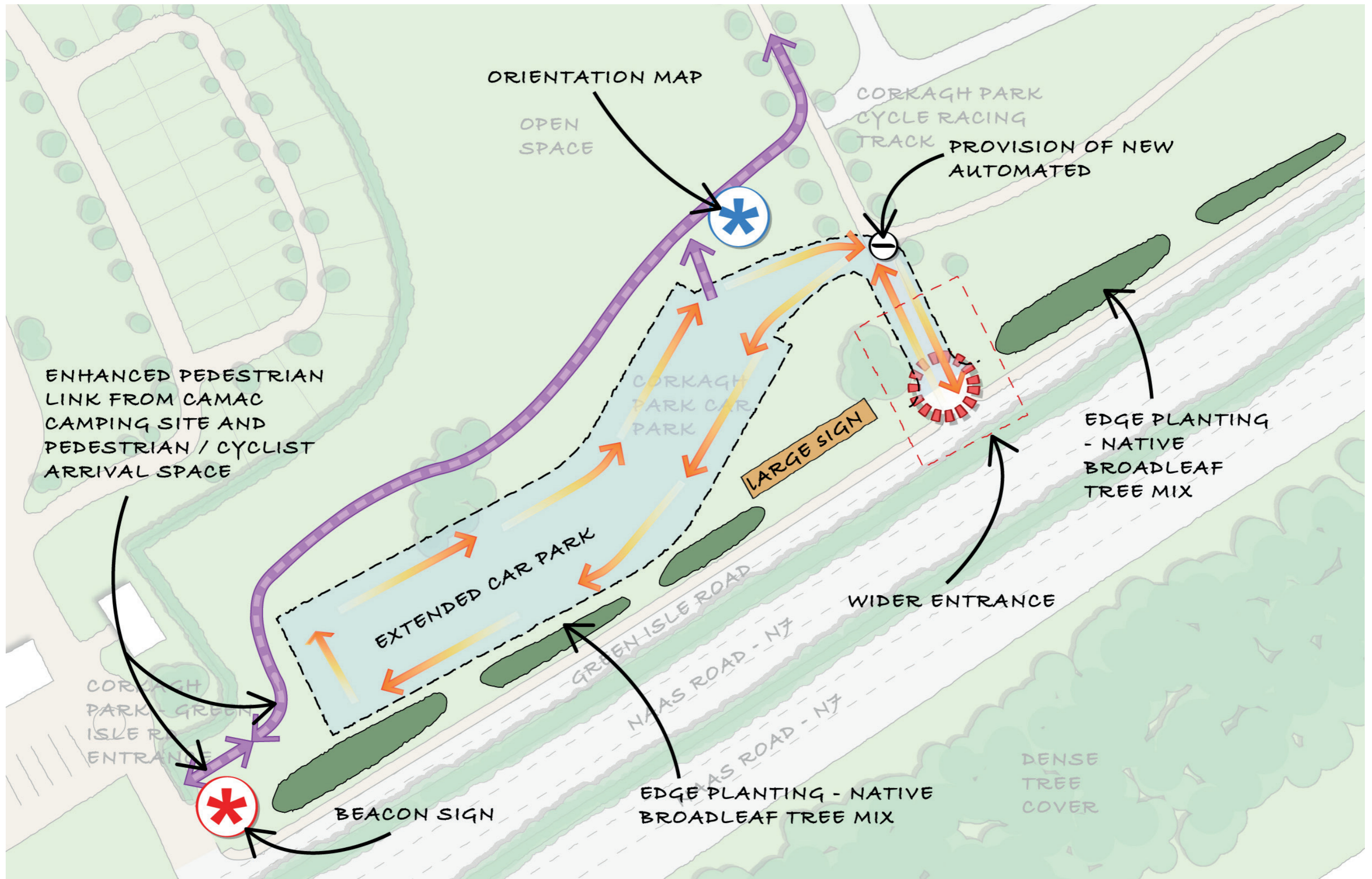

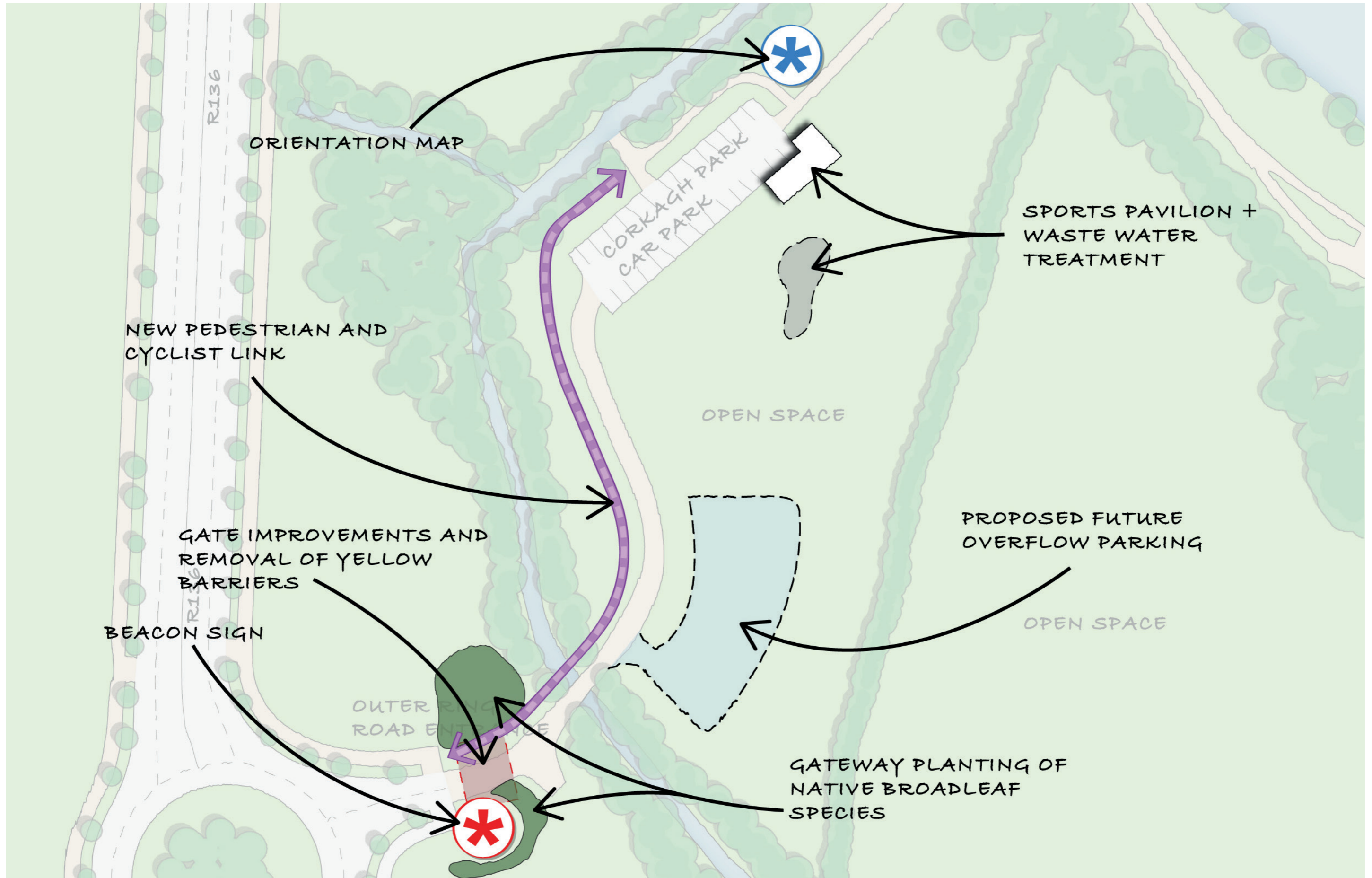

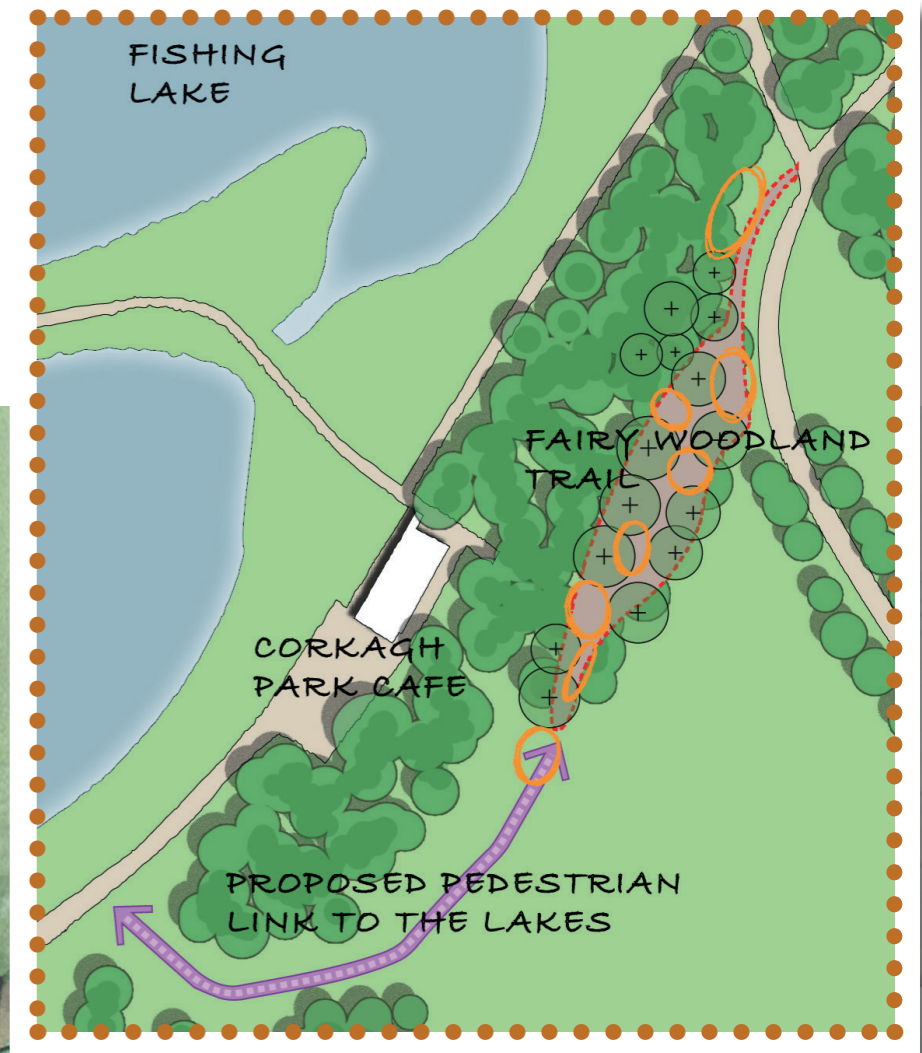
