Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening Determination

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, South Dublin County Council is proposing to upgrade St Cuthbert's Park, in the townlands of Kilmahuddrick and Deansrath, Dublin 22.

It is intended to place the plans and particulars for the development on public display in accordance with the requirements of the Planning and Development Act 2000 to 2011 (as amended) and Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 to 2012 - Part 8.

Having regard to Article 6(3) of the Habitats Directive, the guidance contained in the Department of Housing Planning Community and Local Government's "Appropriate Assessment of Plans and Projects in Ireland Guidance for Planning Authorities" (2010) Screening of the development for Appropriate Assessment was carried out by Malachy Walsh & Partners (MWP) Engineering and Environmental Consultants, Reen Point, Blennerville, Tralee, Co. Kerry, V92 X2TK.

Following initial screening of the proposed development, and based upon best scientific judgement, it is concluded that there will be no likely significant effects from the project on the following Natura 2000 sites:

- Rye Water Valley / Carton SAC
- North Dublin Bay SAC
- South Dublin Bay SAC
- South Dublin Bay and River Tolka Estuary SPA
- North Bull Island SPA
- Glenasmole Valley SAC
- Wicklow Mountains SAC
- Wicklow Mountains SPA

Following an examination, analysis and evaluation of the relevant information and potential for significant effects on the conversation objectives of Natura 2000 sites, and application of the Precautionary Principle, the Report determines, on the basis of objective information that the proposed development; either alone or in-combination with other plans and projects, will not result in likely significant effects on any European site in view of their conservation objectives. A Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment is therefore not required.

For the reasons outlined above it is considered that the proposal for the upgrade St Cuthbert's Park, in the townlands of Kilmahuddrick and Deansrath, Dublin 22, will not

present a risk to any Natura 2000 sites. As such this screening exercise concludes that an Appropriate Assessment is not required for this project.
