What is Cruinniú na nÓg

A national day of creativity for children and young people. It's Ireland's national day for 'doing', 'making' and 'creating'. Funding is from Creative Ireland

Takes place throughout South Dublin and the rest of the island

Activities can be in design, construction, woodworking, gaming, sewing, knitting, cooking, baking, gardening, filmmaking, app creation

Applications

SDCC received 28 applications from individuals and organisations throughout South Dublin

18 projects were awarded in Adamstown, Lucan, Clondalkin, Perrystown, Tallaght, Greenhills

Projects were chosen by a selection panel that consisted of a 9 year old and an external arts advisor from outside of the county

Activities awarded include theatre, music, visual arts and circus

What were we looking for ?

- activities must take place in South Dublin County Council area

- they must be for children and young people from 0 – 18 years of age

- the activity can take place over a few weeks before Cruinniu and after Cruinniu but they must have an event that takes place on Cruinniu day

Who: open to everyone

Age: 5-12 years old

What: Sióg is for young people and families exploring fairy folklore, magic and relationship with the environment. Young people will be invited to create a set for a theatre piece. These creative making sessions will include painting, knitting and crochet, embroidery, pyrography, batik, and woodcraft and will help make a theatre set which will be

Where: The workshops will take place for 6 weeks in Tallaght and a final installation and celebration day on Cruinniú na nÓg in Tymon Park.



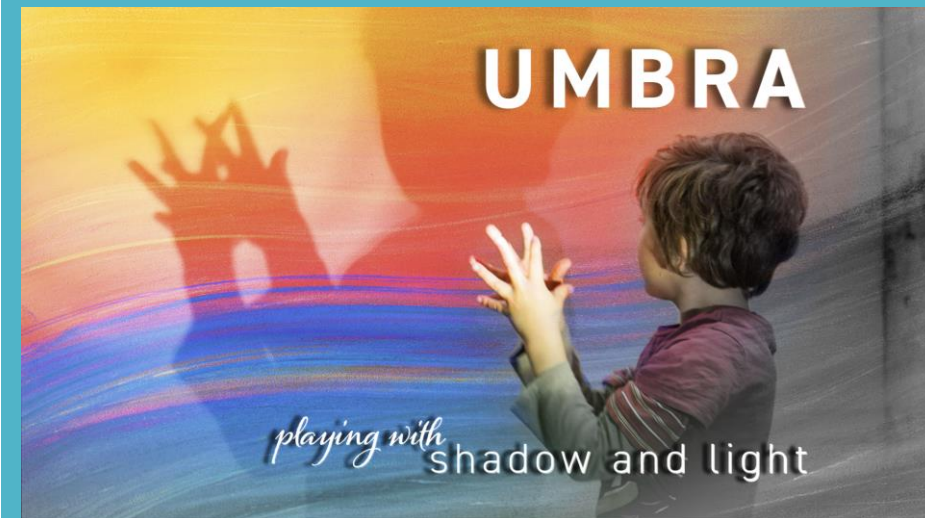
Who: artist Paula Mongey with children from Tallaght Hospital

What: Umbra - playing with shadow and light', is an interactive workshop for children attending the Children's Hospital Umbra connects art, drama, puppetry, movement and sound. There will be 'discovery boxes' full of materials for us to explore, we will make marks and shapes and create puppets in a session of playful and engaged activity
