Thank you for your letter of 19 April 2023 regarding the above. The position in relation to your enquiry is as follows.

Clondalkin Area Committee Meeting of South Dublin County Council (19/04/2023)

Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII) wish to advise that Luas stops do not typically include the provision of public toilets. This is a common approach across public transport where toilets are only provided within stations. Issues regarding the management of cleanliness and the potential for misuse for on street public toilets are generally seen to outweigh the benefits to the public.

However, the Red Cow, as a major transport interchange hub between bus and Luas, is an exception to this approach. The final configuration of the bus interchange will include public toilets and secure bike parking in either lockers or standalone structures and will open in mid to late 2024.
