Mobile Libraries Highlights

The Mobile Library visited 152 publics stops in May and welcomed 2962 visitors. We made 16 visits to primary schools. Our Library@Home service continues to deliver books to vulnerable people in the community and 105 home deliveries were made in May. We held a further 11 outreach events in May including 4 creche visits, 3 afterschool club vistis, the regular monthly visit to the Ukrainian refugee centre at Citywest, and a new monthly visit to the Transit Hub at Citywest which was very successful, with over 50 residents joining the library on the day.

The Mobiles schedule is filling up for the summer, with morning parks visits in July and August, and Saturday events at the markets in Tymon Park. We'll also be at the Community Services Day in the Square on 22nd July, and the AsIAm 5k Run for Autism event in Corkagh Park on 30th July.
