If you are homeless, rough sleeping or at risk of becoming homeless please contact our Homeless Unit at County Hall Tallaght, Dublin 24.

New presentations can be made and assessed through communication by telephone and email. Appointments can be made where necessary.

Please provide these documents if you are presenting as homeless for the first time.

- 1. Photo ID (for example driver's licence, passport, social welfare card)
- 2. Proof of income
- 3. Proof of last permanent address
- 4. Proof of homelessness (for example, a notice to quit, copy of lease agreement, local authority surrender, eviction notice or court order)

All documents can be e-mailed directly to the homeless unit or delivered in person to the post box at porters desk in County Hall, Tallaght.

If you are assessed as homeless, temporary accommodation, where available, will be organised through our Placement Service.
