
Aim of 2023 – 2029 Strategy


Objective 1: Increase the number of locations of recycling facilities

1A: Review all Council owned locations for compliance with Siting Criteria, prioritising areas of recycling deficit.

1B: Seek to include recycling facilities in all publicly funded projects, which meet the siting criteria

1C: Engage with communities, elected representatives, and members of the public to identify possible locations

1D: Support the implementation of the Deposit Return Scheme (DRS) within the county. (IE7 Objective 1)






Objective 2: Seek to include recycling facilities in new developments

Action 2A: Ensure provision of public recycling facilities in new commercial developments and extensions of existing developments.

Action 2B: Require suitable waste management provisions in all developments.







Objective 3: Retain and improve existing recycling sites

Action 3A: Implement an improved inspection and maintenance program for bring centre sites.

Action 3B: Create a register of clothes bank sites and collect information on tonnages collected.

Action 3C: Explore proposals for new service contracts for site improvements (e.g., painting and signage).

Action 3D: Implement a monitoring program to penalize misuse of recycling facilities.

Action 3E: Engage with relevant bodies on the recommendations of the 2020 National Review of Civic Amenity Sites.

Action 3F: Review potential for service expansion in line with the Waste Action Plan for a Circular Economy.

Action 3G: Examine innovative solutions for locations requiring new types of bring bank facilities, considering disability access.

Objective 4: Increase the usage of recycling facilities


Action 4A: Implement a communication program to increase awareness of recycling facilities.

Action 4B: Improve community awareness of the recycling network via the council's online platforms.

Objective 5: Contract Provision

Action 5A: Collaborate with Dublin Local Authorities on awarding and managing a new regional glass collection contract.

Action 5B: Explore potential service contracts for textile collection






Objective 6: Database Management

Action 6A: Develop and maintain a database of all recycling facilities within the county.

Action 6B: Maintain an online directory of recycling services available to the public.
