### Season of Science


Season of Science, supported by Science Foundation Ireland, is running throughout the month of November, bringing scientific exploration to the curious of all ages.


NCL also hosted music tech workshops with NOISE Music and a Great Creative with Rubbish workshop for schools.


























## ComicFest 2023


