

Libraries Report | December 2023

November Statistics

- Ballyroan Library had 26,063 visitors in November. We hosted 97 events with a total of 2856 attendees.
 17,438 items were issued and 451 new members joined the library.
- Castletymon had 5202 visitors, borrowing almost 3444 items and added 106 new members.



November Highlights Ballyroan – children and teens

Christmas Craft Fair Saturday, 25th November. We had a great turn out for our annual Christmas Craft Fair. There were over 50 crafters with stalls in the library and parish centre. Entertainment was provided by RUGs.

Volcanoes: Natural Wonders and Civilization Destroyers. Saturday 11th November. What are volcanoes? How do they work? Why do people live so close to them? In this workshop we answer these questions and more, take a closer look at what happened to the Roman city of Pompeii, and make our own erupting volcanoes! As part of Season of Science we hosted 2 of these children's workshops.

Comic Fest: In Conversation with Stephen Mooney and Declan Shalvey. Thursday 9th November. Declan Shalvey and Stephen Mooney are two of the most prolific and successful Irish comic creators currently working. Declan has worked extensively for major American publishers such as Marvel, DC, Image and Dark Horse drawing titles such as Venom, Moon Knight, Thunderbolts, Dark Avengers, Winter Soldier, Deadpool, All-Star Batman, Conan The Barbarian and much more. He is currently writing and drawing Alien for Marvel comics. He has also written two crime graphic novels set in Ireland, Savage Town, illustrated by Philip Barrett, and Bog Bodies, illustrated by Gavin Fullerton, both published by Image Comics. Stephen Mooney is the New York Times best-selling author of HALF PAST DANGER from IDW. He has illustrated numerous comics for Marvel, such as Carnage, Star Wars and Black Widow. He has also worked for DC, Image, Valiant, Dark Horse, Dynamite and many other major US publishers. Stephen has also written for series such as STAR TREK, THE PHANTOM, BETTIE PAGE and SHEENA: QUEEN OF THE JUNGLE.
