In October Clondalkin Library hosted the following Library Labs events



- Maths Detectives workshops for primary and secondary school groups


In October the Library Labs programme won an SDCC Staff Innovation Award in the Innovation in Service Delivery Category.

Mobile Libraries Highlights

The mobile library service had almost 4,000 visitors to its public stops in September, in addition to 20 school visits and 96 Library @ Home Deliveries.

In October mobiles issued 8653 items and registered 259 new members.

A new stop at the Ukrainian modular housing at Stonewell, Lucan has been hugely popular, with 120 people signing up for library membership on the first day, and an average of 95 people borrowing books each week since.

During the October mid-term break, the mobile library has attended Hallowe'en camps at Knockmitten Community Centre, and the Park Community Centre, Firhouse, as well as visiting the cadets at Casement Aerodrome, where over 50 signed up for library membership.
