

Schemes Proposed in South Dublin


The **Wellington Lane Scheme** forms an integral part of a new and comprehensive cycle network being progressed by SDCC.

The Cycle South Dublin programme has the main objective of providing a comprehensive and connected cycle network across South Dublin as well as making cycling a more achievable mode of transport for adults and children.

The Wellington Lane Scheme will contribute to providing key links and connections to other cycle routes proposed within the County.

The junction proposal was developed in consultation with DCC.

Location of proposed works

The Whitehall Road Trial Scheme forms part of the Wellington Lane - Wellington Road - Whitehall Road corridor and is part of the Cycle South Dublin Network.


Part 8 Consultation was carried out in September and October of 2022. A trial scheme will be provided.






Location of proposed works


The Whitehall Road Trial Scheme runs from north of the Greentrees Road Roundabout to the junction with Kimmage Road West located on the DCC Boundary



















Opportunities & Constraints of the Proposals

Opportunities	Constraints
Higher level of service for pedestrians & cyclists along Whitehall Road	Vehicular capacity is not expanded as significant new capacity is provided for pedestrian and cyclists movements
Aligns with NTA/SDCC/DCC Policies for active travel enhancements	No-Right-Turn from Whitehall Road into Rockfield Drive. Traffic from Kimmage Road West destined for Rockfield Avenue must enter form Shelton Grove.
Forms a connection between SDCC/DCC proposed active travel schemes	
Improved junction at Kimmage Road West	
Easier to see pedestrian and cyclists due to modification of junction geometry / layout
