

Castletymon Library December Highlights

In November Castletymon Library issued 3534 items, registered 74 new members and had 5575 visitors.

For Children and Teens, we have **Glow Group: Robotics and Coding** for TY on Friday 6th December, a **Christmas Picturebook Storytime with Julianne McKeigue** on Tuesday 10th, as well as a **Visit from Santa** on Weds 11th for our regular **Parent and Toddler Group**. Finally, we have **Christmas Crafts for Kids with Kim Jenkinson** (16th).

Our very popular **Christmas Craft Fair** returns on 7th December from 11am – 4pm, with a special Christmas performance from **Danny Magic** at 12pm.

For Adults, our regular **Spanish Conversation**, **Knitting Group** and **Adult Book Club** continue into December. For Christmas, we are focussed on music with the **Christmas Edition of our Music Session** (11th) and a special performance of **Christmas Songs by the Firhouse Ukulele Group** on Sat 14th. To round out the season, we have a two-part **Christmas Watercolours Workshop** on 16th & 18th.

Mobile Libraries Highlights

In November the Mobile libraries issued 8672 items, registered 432 new members and had 7413 visitors.

Mobile Libraries have 36 weekly public stops and are consistently yielding a high footfall this winter. Acting on public feedback, the Fettercairn stop has been reinstated to an earlier time in December at 2.30pm and our new Elder Heath Green stop in Kiltipper is going to a slightly later time at 3.30pm.

We visited Tallaght Youthreach on 6th December. We will also make our last visits to St Michael's House and Citywest Hotel in 2024 festive visits with treats for our patrons. We will be visiting Bloomfield Care Home with a music session from The Christmas Crooners on 18th December to mark the opening of a newly refurbished area in the home. There is also a surprise event booked for 19th Dec for our last visit before Christmas to the Ukrainian community at Stonewell, Lucan. This stop has an average of 80 people visiting in the 40 mins that we are there, mostly young families.
