

February Stats NCL, Lucan, Palmerstown & Mobile Libraries

- NCL had 212 events attended by 1784 people, issued 3978 items and registered 136 new borrowers and had 9185 visitors.
- Lucan Library had 62 events, issued 9,908 items and registered 221 new borrowers and had 10,421 visitors.
- Palmerstown Library issued 905 items and registered 35 new borrowers and had 1536 visitors.
- Mobile Libraries issued 7764 items and registered 84 new borrowers.
