- NCL had 214 events attended by 2409 people, issued 3476 items and registered 98 new borrowers and had 9236 visitors.
- Lucan Library had 65 events, issued 9,477 items and registered 204 new borrowers and had 11,096 visitors.
- Palmerstown Library issued 760 items and registered 55 new borrowers and had 1594 visitors.
- Mobile Libraries issued 9022 items and registered 110 new borrowers.

• April was a busy month in North Clondalkin Library. In total over 100 library-organised events took place. Demand for room bookings by individuals and organisations continues to increase.


