# LUCAN VILLAGE PUBLIC REALM SCHEME

# Lucan Masterplan

The Lucan Village Public Realm Scheme is part of a wider Lucan Masterplan by SDCC following the village's designation as a Destination Town. This project is the first in the series of three projects to improve placemaking in Lucan and deliver a more engaging and rewarding public realm spaces for all.

The following are part of the first project subdivided into three sites - the Village Green, the Riverside Promenade and the Lucan Demesne Park Entrance.





# 1. Village Green

## Aims for the Village Green

- Create a sense of arrival into the Village Green
- Encourage interaction, visual and physical from the park
- Improve sightlines into the Village Green
- Replace guarding to the canal
- Improve narrow Dispensary Lane footpath
- Improve Landscaping
- Improve accessibility into the park
- Provide seating, bins and street furniture
- Provide focal point to the space (performance, seating etc)



Planting to the village green will include trees and shrubs such as spindleberry, serviceberry, hydrangea and lavender as well as over 600 perennials and grasses.

## 2. Riverside Promenade



- New seating area at existing steps adjacent to Watery lane with high quality finish
- New steps and seats adjacent to Lucan Bridge with high quality finish
- Planting including silver birches, Spindle trees, different types of flowering plants, shrubs and over 500 perennials and grasses

### 3. Lucan Demesne Park Entrance.



- ❑ Timber cladding placed along park side to create views over historic stone bridge and to mitigate anti-social behaviour
- ❑ Green-walling of existing boundary walls
- ❑ Portal structure to mark the entrance to the park
- ❑ Surface to be finished with high quality paving slab
- ❑ 2 new carparks
- ❑ Planted boundary on roadside to screen traffic sound pollution



# Project Update

## 1. Village Green

- Works are nearing 50% completion
- Undergrounding works complete and overhead cables to be removed in early July 2025 subject to ESB scheduling
- Works to be completed in October 2025

## 2. Riverside Promenade

- Works are nearing 50% completion
- Works to be complete in September 2025

## 3. Lucan Demesne Carpark

- Works are nearing 50% completion
- Undergrounding works complete and overhead cables to be removed in early June 2025
- Works to be completed in September 2025
