May Stats NCL, Lucan, Palmerstown & Mobile Libraries

NCL had 227 events attended by 764 people, issued 3084 items and registered 90 new borrowers and had 9161 visitors.

Lucan Library had 61 events, issued 8480 items and registered 279 new borrowers and had 14,586 visitors. My Open Library registered 65 new borrowers and 1699 visitors used the service. My Open Library has been very busy as we approach the State exams.

Palmerstown Library issued 864 items and registered 38 new borrowers and had 1749 visitors.

Mobile Libraries issued 8756 items and registered 66 new borrowers.


