## **Public Consultation Process**

- Statutorily obliged to engage in public consultation including public display / consideration of submissions
- Draft Scheme presented to Council 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025
- Public Consultation commenced Tuesday 15th July and extended to Wednesday 16th September 2025
- Draft Scheme published in local & national media / Council's consultation portal http://consult.sdublincoco.ie
- Circulated to Minister(s) & Elected Members
- 4 Submissions received

## Background / Legislative Basis

- Draft Scheme presented to Council 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025
- S.48 P&D Act 2020, as amended specifies basis for making a Development Contribution Scheme
- Contributions in respect of public infrastructure & facilities benefitting private development
- Making scheme is Reserved Function of Elected Members
- Current scheme approved in October 2020, effective 01/01/21 to 31/12/25
- New scheme required to be effective from 01/01/26, subject to approval of Council



## **Draft Scheme 2026 Recap**

- No increase in current rates per m<sup>2</sup>
  - Residential €126.45
  - Non Residential €119.52
- CDP objectives mechanism included for contributions in lieu of public open space/community facilities
- Sustainable development incentivesupper floors use, derelict/vacancy, surface water, villages, protected structures
- Exemptions and part exemptions from contributions

- Request for exemptions under Protected Structure (S11xvi) where Social and Affordable units are provided

- Request for specific projects in Class 2 Surface Water
- Request for specific projects in Class 4 Parks & Open Spaces
- Request for "offsets" where infrastructure benefits wider community

## Chief Executive's Proposed Amendments

The Chief Executive's response to the submissions and the proposed amendments are set out in the CE Report. The report recommends 10no. Proposed Amendments to the Draft Scheme:

- Inclusion of LDA as eligible body for residential social and affordable exemptions and include in the public open space in lieu and community centre exemptions
- Greater clarity to meaning of social housing units eligible for exemption
- Greater clarity to Part V arrangements to aid and ptomote expedition of delivery
- Additional non residential exemptions for childcare (50%)/ civic / community floorspace/ public parks
- Greater clarity to SUDS/ permeability measure reduction
- Additional exemption towards sustainable transport floorspace measures covered bicycle parking and mobility hubs
- Reference to appeals to An Coimisiún Pleanála to provide greater clarity.

## Chief Executive's Recommendation
