QUESTION NO. 8

QUESTION: Councillor E. Ó Broin

To ask the Chief Executive where people on the social housing list ordinarily resident in the LEA, seek to enter SDCC homeless services, and such accommodation is not available in the LEA, what other locations are offered to them?

REPLY:

The Dublin Region Homeless Executive (DRHE) is provided by Dublin City Council as the lead statutory authority on the response to homelessness in Dublin and adopts a shared service approach across the Dublin region on behalf of South Dublin County Council, Fingal County Council and Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

Following a needs assessment for Emergency Accommodation, eligible applicants will be provided with a placement within the South Dublin administrative area where capacity permits. Should placements within the county be exhausted, the applicant will be directed to the Dublin Regional Homeless Executive (DRHE) Freephone service or the Family Support Team to secure an alternative solution. These placements are generally located within Dublin City Centre or adjacent areas, based on confirmed availability.
