Tallaght, Castletymon and Mobile Libraries ACM Report



Statistics for Tallaght, Castletymon and Mobile Libraries for September

Tallaght library had 19,647 visitors in September; there were 107 events and 12,123 items issued. There were 910 new members

Castletymon Library issued 3554 items and registered 189 new members and had 6,345 visitors.

Mobile Libraries issued 9605 items, registered 257 new borrowers and visited 22 schools



Castletymon Library, October Events for children

Movie of Her Life with author Claire Hennessy (16th) in conversation with Zoe Miller.


Climate Literacy Initiative- two events on 6th, one on making your own wax wrap, another on growing your own salad.

Two computer sessions organised for Cyber Security Month


