Tallaght Stadium - A Rich History

2009 - 2010

- **Inaugural match:** Shamrock Rovers vs Sligo Rovers (3,000 fans).
- **Real Madrid visit;** Cristiano Ronaldo makes his debut.
- East Stand opens (Capacity: 6,000) **First international game: Ireland U21 vs Georgia.**
- Hosts 2010 Shamrock Bowl (Ireland's American Football Championship).

2010 - 2011

- **First European Fixture:** Rovers beat Bnei Yehuda in Europa League Qualifier; next round: Juventus visit Tallaght.
- Wins League of Ireland Pitch of the Year.
- First UEFA Champions League qualifier; Rovers qualify for Europa League group stage.
- **Tottenham Hotspur visit;** temporary stand increases capacity to 8,500.

2013 - 2018

- Hosts first **American Football international match:** Greendell Falcons (CAN) vs Bristol Academy Pride.
- Since 2013 - **Primary venue for Ireland Women's National Team.**
- Hosts **Special Olympics Ireland Games** Opening Ceremony.

2019 - Present

- 2019 South Stand opens; capacity raised to 8,000.
- 2021 Live music returns with Jerry Fish's "Live at the Stadium".
- 2024 – North Stand opens; Stadium now holds 10,000.
- 2025 Hosts prestigious **Leinster Schools Senior Cup Final.**
