Tallaght, Castletymon and Mobile Libraries ACM Report December



November statistics for Tallaght, Castletymon and Mobile libraries

Tallaght library had 20,091 visitors; there were 165 events attended by 2,198 people and 8144 items issued. There were 655 new members

Castletymon Library issued 3277 items, registered 308 new members and had 5623 visitors. They held 46 events attended by 629 people.

Mobile Libraries issued 8222 items, registered 1005 new borrowers and visited 21 schools




For Children:


On 3rd December, Anne from Suimhneas will be educating parents and their babies about the world of Baby Reflexology.
