


## 1 to 1 Smartphone help

In January 2025 Clondalkin Library began offering1-to-1 smartphone sessions in response to a need noticed by staff when helping members of the public at the library desk.

Anyone who needs help getting to grips with their smartphone can make an appointment with a member of staff to get 45 minutes of 1 to 1 help. And can make a follow up appointment if they wish.

From help with WhatsApp or emails to downloading boarding passes, no query is too small.

68 sessions have taken place since January 2025

Other assistive technologies available at Clondalkin Library:


