November Stats Ballyroan, Castletymon & Mobile Libraries

Ballyroan had 142 events attended by 1855 people, issued 14629 items, registered 740 new borrowers and had 22,601 visitors.

Castletymon Library had 46 events, issued 3277 items, registered 307 new borrowers and had 5623 visitors.

Mobile Libraries issued 8222 items, registered 1005 new borrowers and visited 21 schools in November

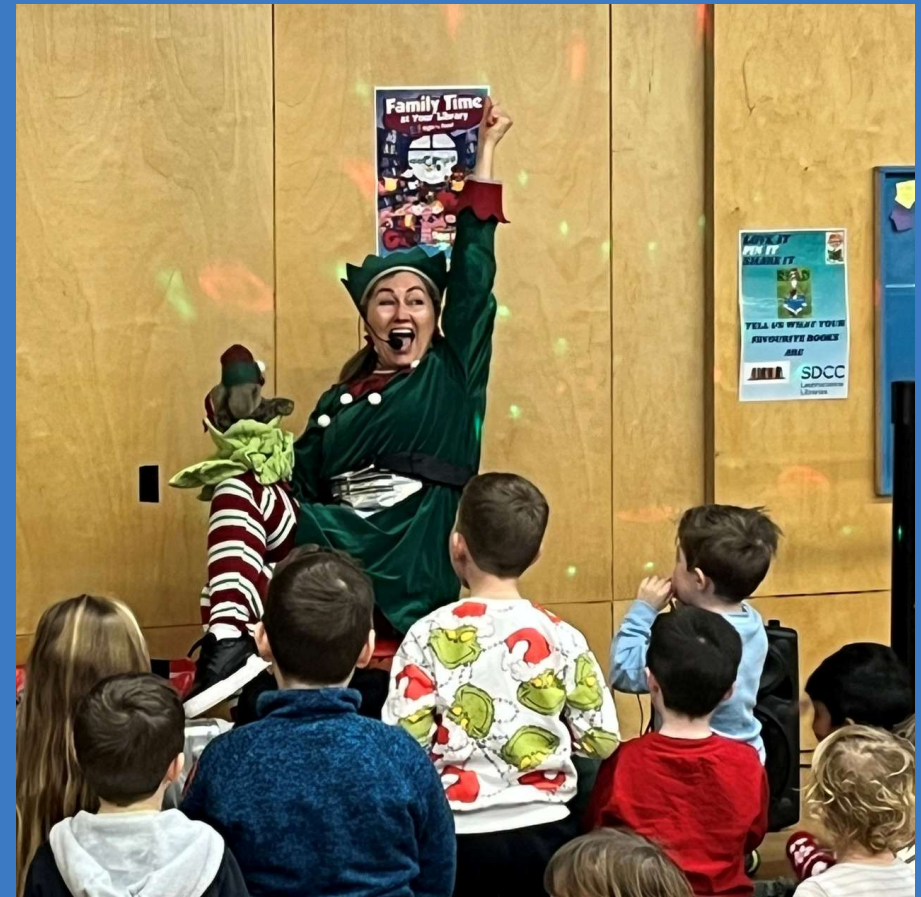


Ballyroan January Highlights – Families, Children and Teens

- The Tymon Sessions trad music with take place on Wednesday the 14th of January

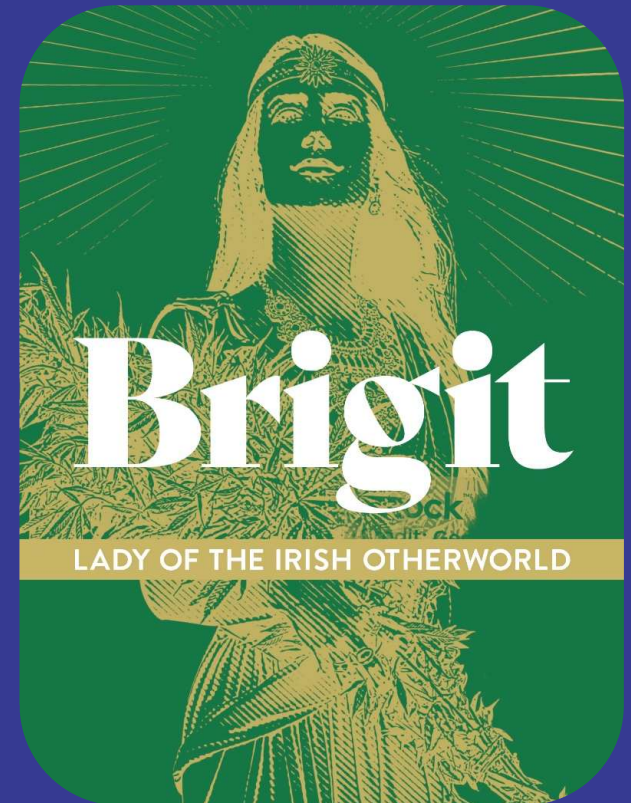
History and Heritage
