

E-Scooters

E-Scooters are a convenient mode of transport, but you have a duty of care to yourself & other road users. You also need to be sure that your e-scooter is road legal.

E-Scooters are Restricted to

-  A maximum weight unladen of **25 kilograms**
-  A maximum design speed of **20 kilometres** per hour
-  A maximum power of **400w**

E-Scooters MUST HAVE

-  **Front and rear lights**
-  A **Bell/Horn**
-  **Front /Rear brakes**

E-Scooters are NOT allowed

-  On **Footpaths/motorways**
-  To **Carry passengers** or goods
-  To **Have a seat**

E-Scooters Users

-  **16+** **Must** be over 16 years old
-  Cannot use the scooter while intoxicated
-  Failure to adhere to Road Traffic legislation may incur a **Fine/Court Summons**
